
## Verrucosa arenata an orb weaver



ORDER:ARANEAE INFRAORDER:Araneomorphae FAMILY:Araneidae

TAXONOMIC\_COMMENTS: First described in 1833 as Epeira mexicana by Lucas, that name was sunk as nomen oblitum in 1976, so it took the specific epithet from Walckenaer in 1841, when he described it as E. arenata. It was moved to the genus Verrucosa by McCook in 1888.

DISTRIBUTION\_COMMENTS: Eastern deciduous forests, gardens, suburban plantings.

HABITAT: forest edge, forest
