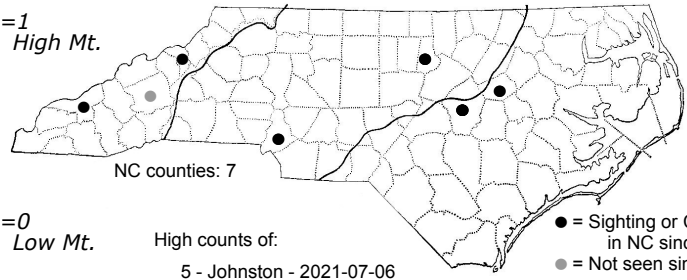
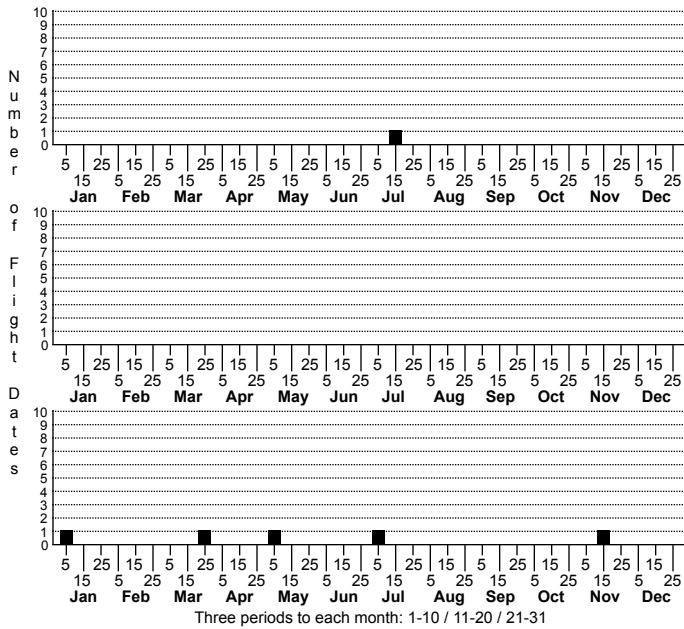
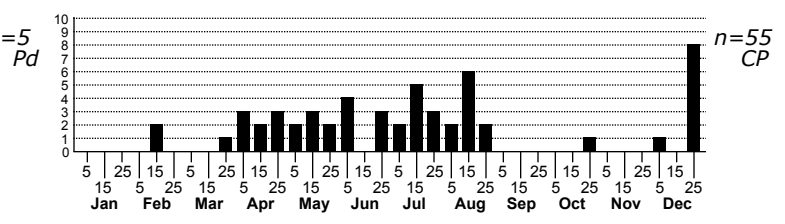


*Erigone autumnalis* a dwarf spider

DISTRIBUTION\_COMMENTS: Canada; Maine to Florida, west to Kansas and Texas. Central America to Panama. Introduced to Azores, Europe, United Arab Emirates, and New Caledonia.

HABITAT: old field; sifted from moss near ditch. Frequently found under fallen leaves.

OBSERVATION\_METHODS: Johnston Co. specimens frequently taken in Berlese samples of soil & leaf litter in residential neighborhood.
