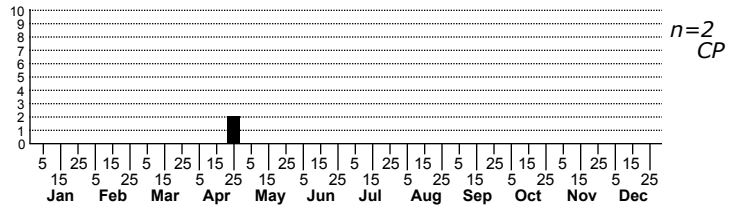
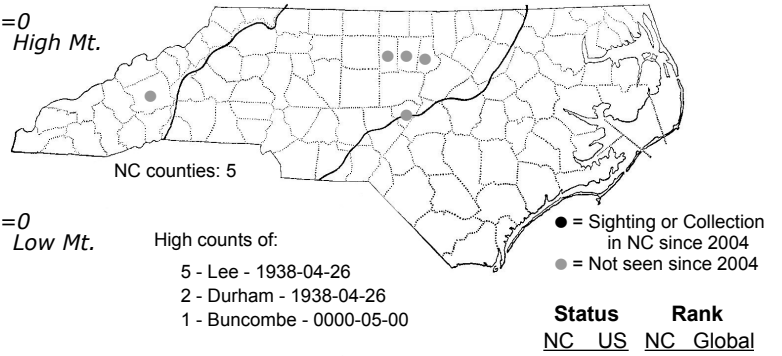
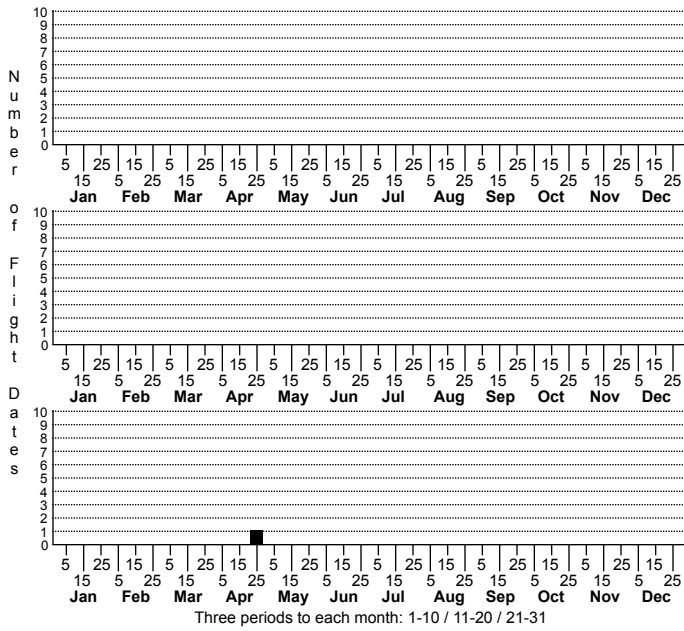


Geolycosa fatifera No common name
