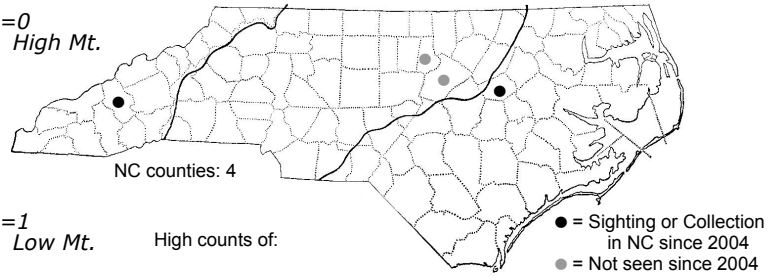
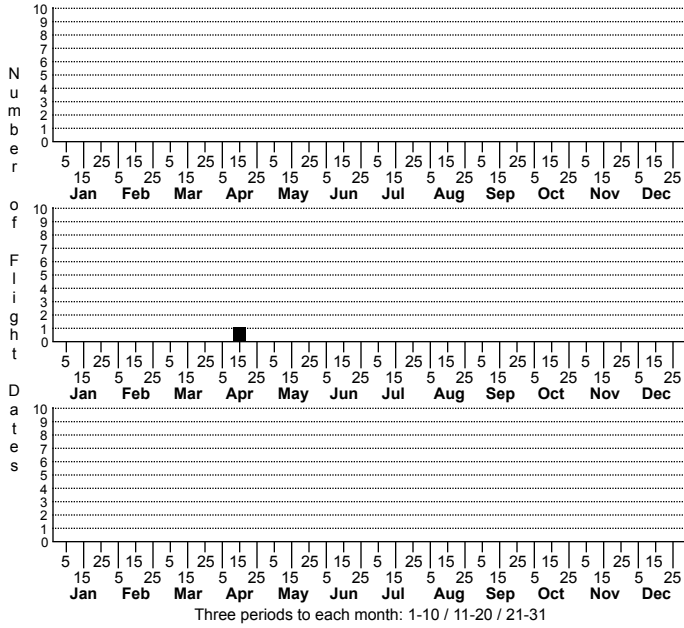


*Acanthepeira cherokee* an orbweaver

DISTRIBUTION\_COMMENTS: Probably more common in the Piedmont and coastal plain, scattered records throughout the southeast. Eggs hatch in July and overwinter as subadults. Adults mature in spring and early summer.

HABITAT: Likely the same as others in the genus, old fields, grasslands, sand dune vegetation, meadows, forest under story, structures and occasionally in trees.

OBSERVATION\_METHODS: Collected by sweep netting or visual surveys.
