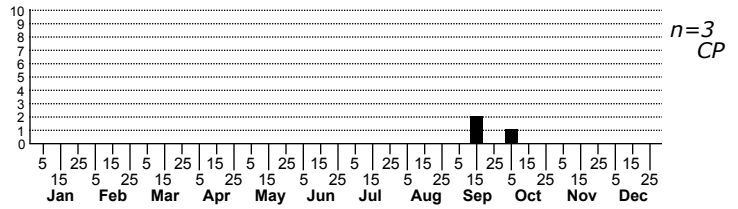
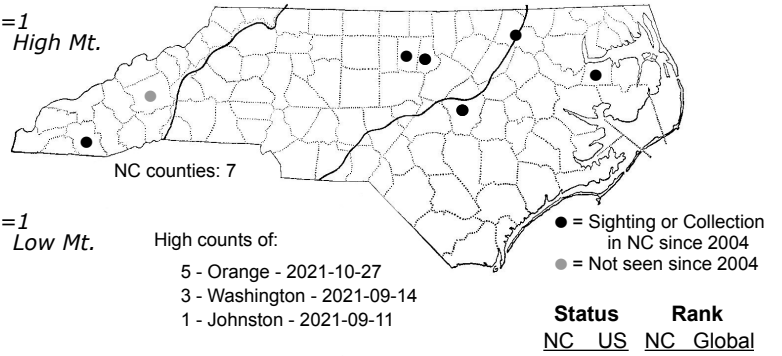
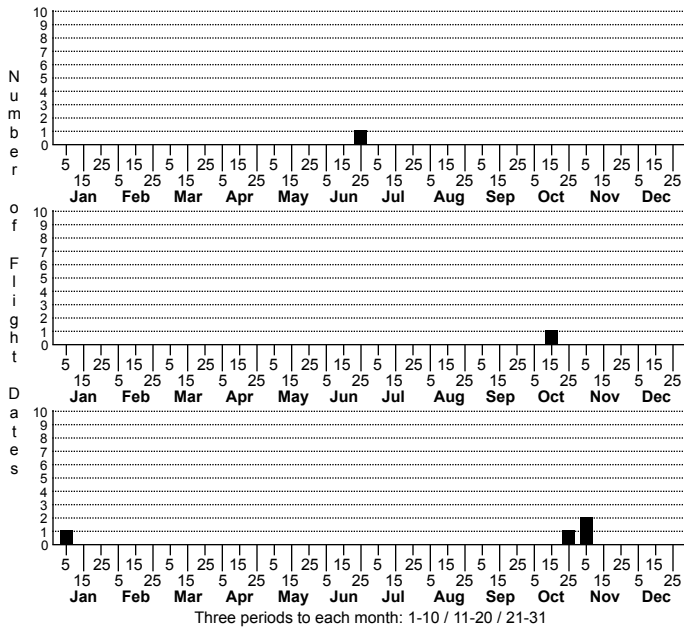


Microdipoena guttata a minute clasping weaver

DISTRIBUTION_COMMENTS: E. USA, MA, NY, NJ; MO east to NC; southeast to FL

HABITAT: Taken by sifting in dry leaves in woods and at edges of swamps.

OBSERVATION_METHODS: Rarely seen, owing to small size. Generally found by sifting or Berlese funnel.
