

List of the Marine Fish species of North Carolina - printed 2026-03-07

This is a listing of the species of marine fishes that are known to occur off the coast of the state, without regard to the territorial 3-mile limit. The list was compiled by Fritz Rohde, Scott Smith, and Christina Schobernd in 2020 and is found on the NCFishes website: <<https://ncfishes.com/marine-fishes-of-north-carolina/>>. There are 747 native plus 2 non-native marine species on this list. There are 34 species on both freshwater and marine lists (marked with an *). Therefore, there are 258 Fresh + 749 Marine - 34 = 973 fish species in NC waters.
