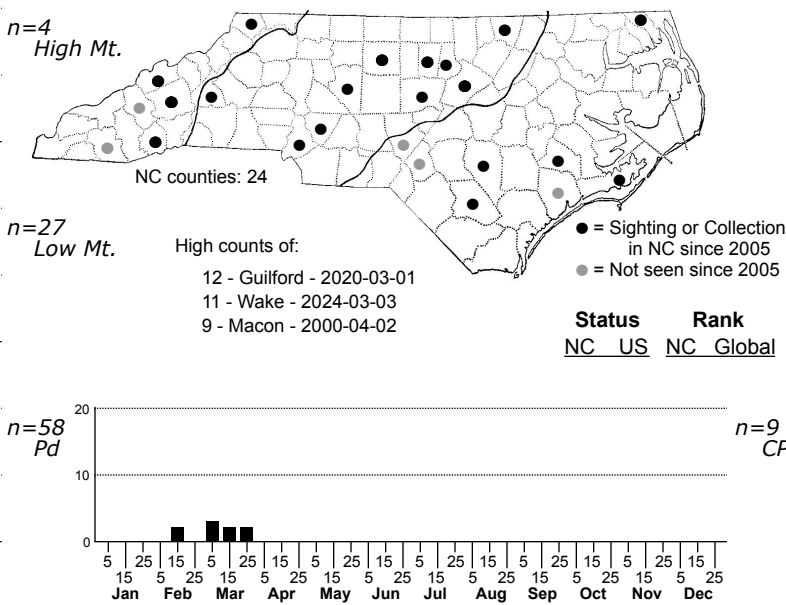
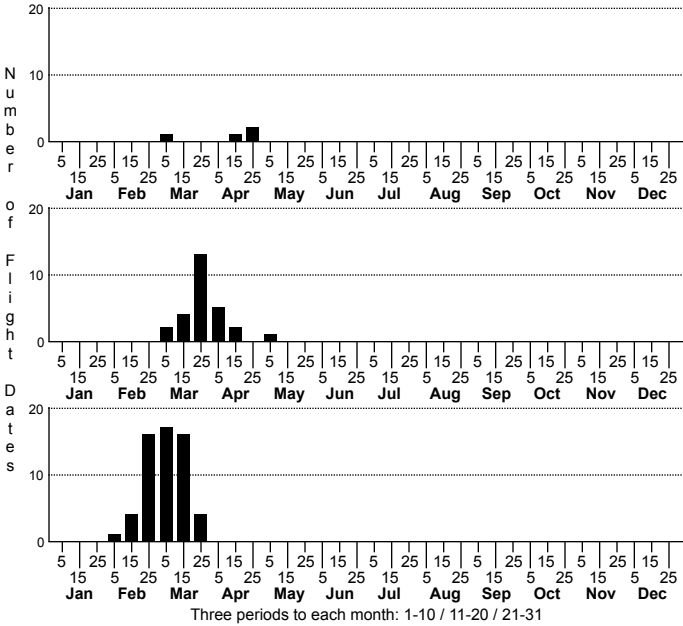


Psaphida rolandi Roland's Sallow

FOOD: Larvae feed on oaks (Wagner et al., 2011). In North Carolina, J.B. Sullivan has reared larvae from Bluejack Oak (*Quercus incana*) and Turkey Oak (*Q. laevis*).
