




Sympistis badistriga Brown-lined Sallow

HABITAT:

FOOD: Larvae feed on honeysuckle (*Lonicera* spp.), including Limber Honeysuckle (*L. dioica*). Reports from various hardwoods (Robinson et al., 2010) are questionable and require verification. Limber Honeysuckle is restricted to the mountains in North Carolina, so other species of *Lonicera* must be used elsewhere.
