




Sympistis chionanthi Fringe-tree Sallow

HABITAT:

FOOD: Reported hosts include Fringetree (*Chionanthus virginicus*) and ash (*Fraxinus*) (Wagner et al., 2011).

STATE PROTECTION: Has no legal protection, although permits are required to collect it on state parks and other public lands.

COMMENTS: This species appears to be very rare in the state and the threats to its host plant, Fringetree, from the depredations of the Emerald Ash Borer are quite high
