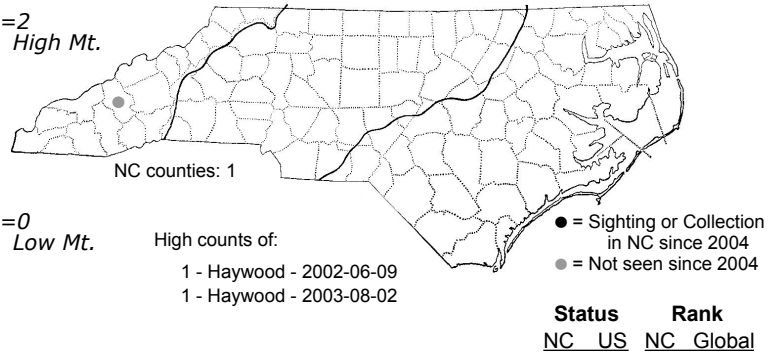
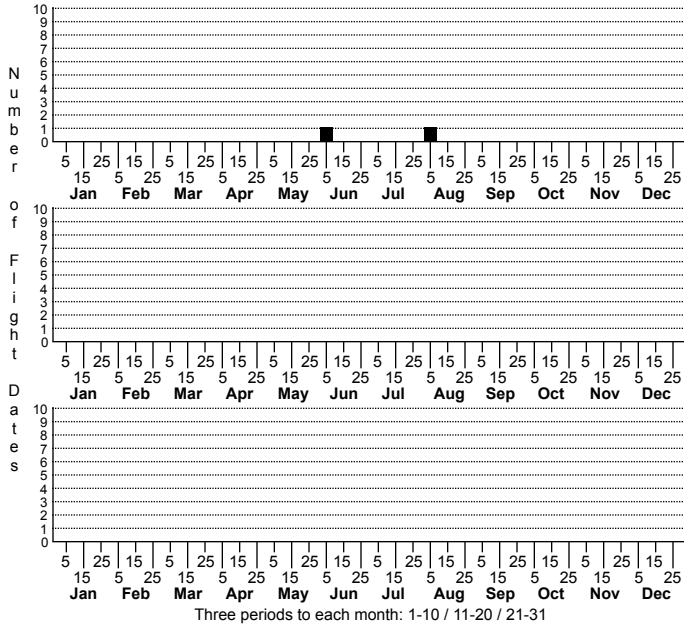

FOOD: Reported hosts include goldenrod (<i>Solidago</i>), Grass-leaved Flat-top Goldenrod (<i>Euthamia graminifolia</i>), Common Horseweed (<i>Erigeron canadensis</i>), Annual Fleabane (<i>Erigeron annuus</i>), and Tall Flat-top Aster (<i>Doellingeria umbellata</i>) (McCabe, 1991; Robinson et al., 2010; BugGuide).
