



HABITAT:

FOOD: Host plants are poorly documented, but Robinson et al. (2010) list dandelion (*Taraxacum*). We do not have any feeding records in North Carolina.

STATE PROTECTION: Has no legal protection, although permits are required to collect it on state parks and other public lands.

COMMENTS: This species appears to be primarily Midwestern in its distribution with only a few records east of the Appalachians. Currently, we do not know if our records represent rare strays or established populations.
