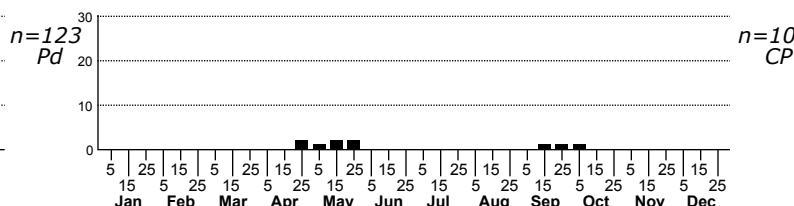
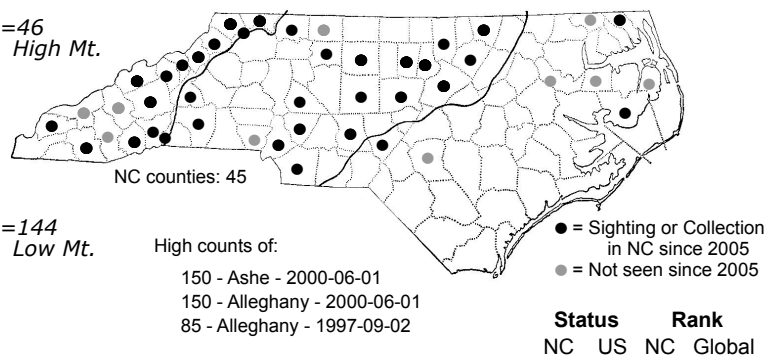
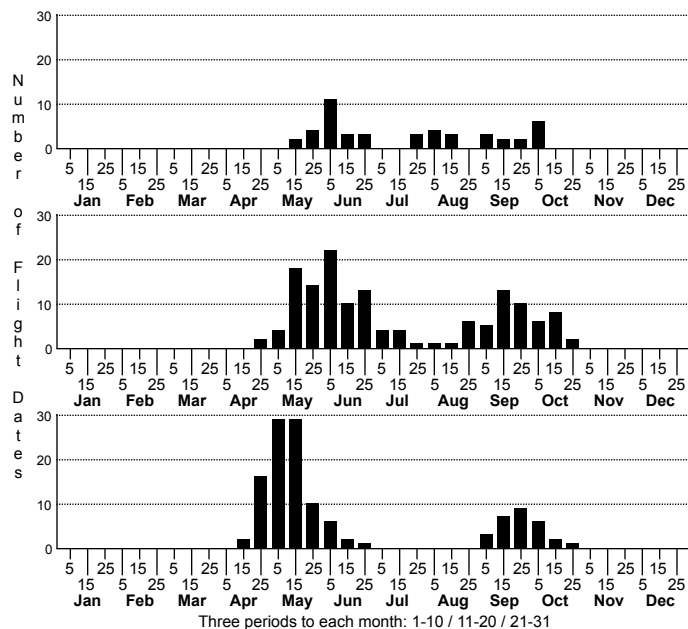


Lacinipolia renigera Bristly Cutworm Moth

FOOD: Larvae are polyphagous on both graminoids and forbs, including many crop species; also recorded on apple (*Malus*), grape (*Vitis*), and poplar (*Populus*) (Wagner et al., 2011). We do not have any feeding records in North Carolina.
