

FOOD: Host plants are poorly documented, but Beadle & Leckie (2018) list dandelion (<i>Taraxacum</i>).

STATE PROTECTION: Has no legal protection, although permits are required to collect it on state parks and other public lands.

COMMENTS: This soouthern species appears to be established along the coast in South Carolina but its status as a resident species in North Carolina needs to be demonstrated. Currently, it is known only from a single historic record.
