HABITAT: Habitats include forests and woodlands (Wagner et al., 2012). Our records come from bottomland and mesic and dryxeric upland forests.

FOOD: Larvae feed on a wide range of shrub species, representing a number of different families. Wagner et al. (2011) specifically list chokeberry (<i>Aronia</i>), hazel (<i>Corylus</i>), laurel (<i>Kalmia</i>), American Hop-hornbeam (<i>Ostrya virginiana</i>), cherry (<i>Prunus</i>), blueberry (<i>Vaccinium</i>), and <i>Viburnum</i>).
