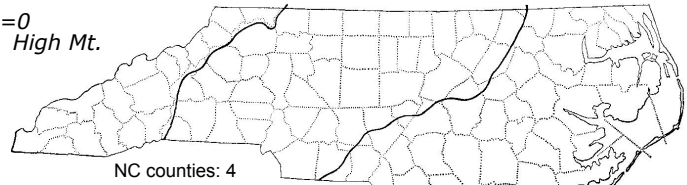


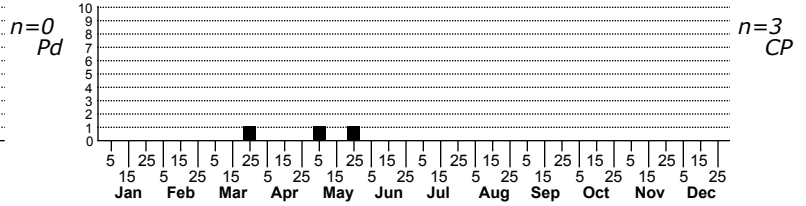
Xanthopastis regnatrix Spanish Moth
