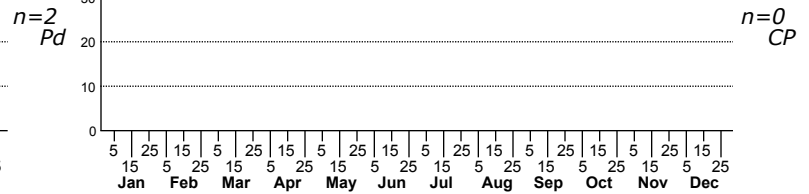
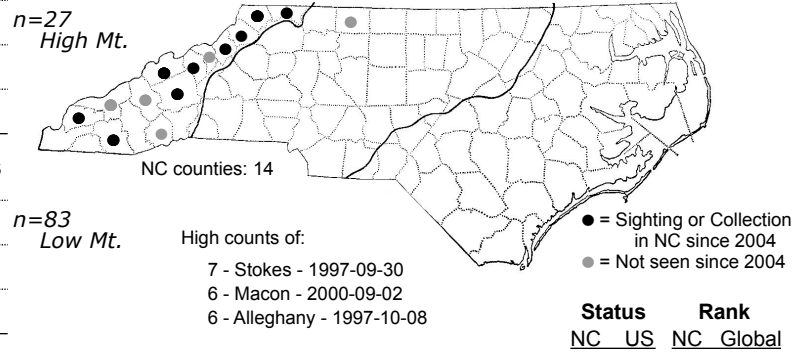
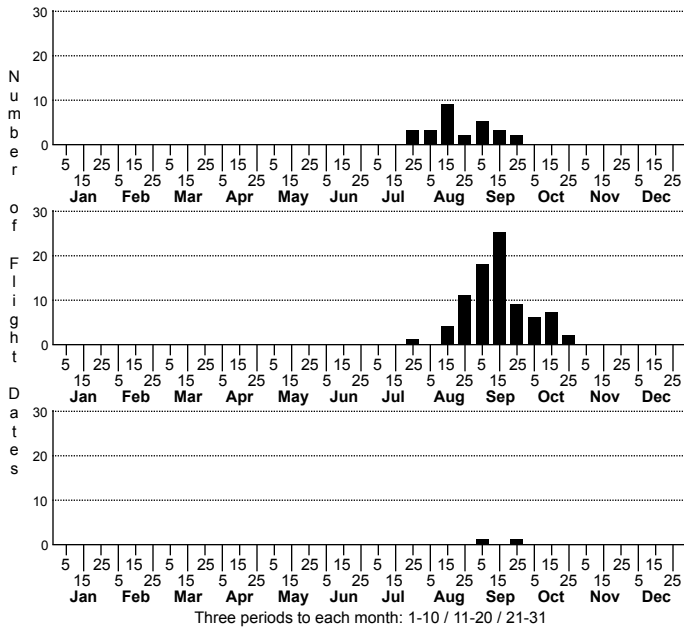


Xestia smithii Smith's Dart Moth
