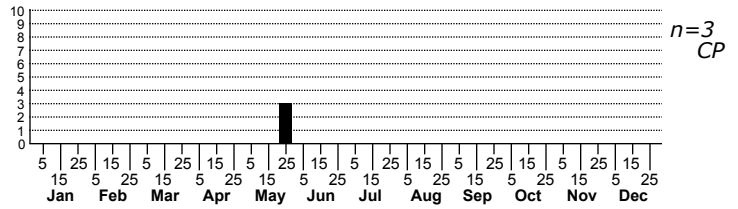
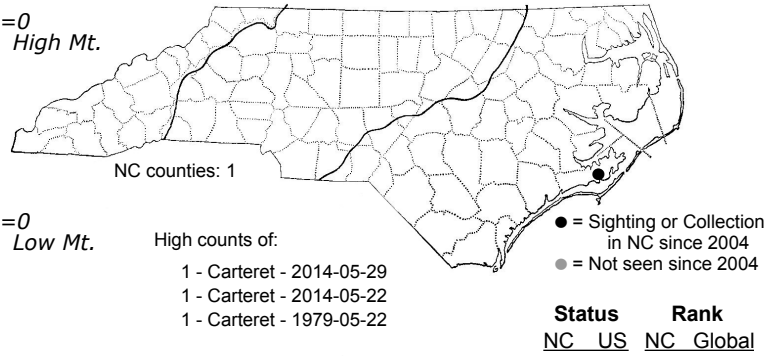
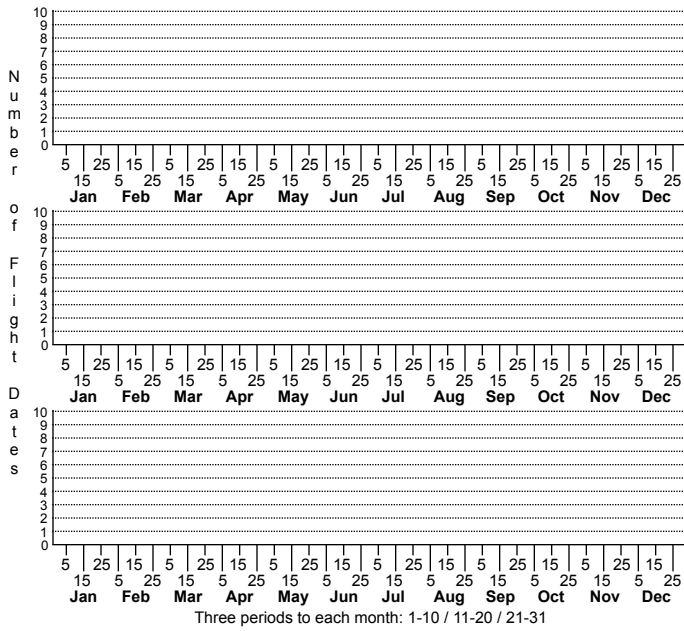


Schinia mitis No common name
