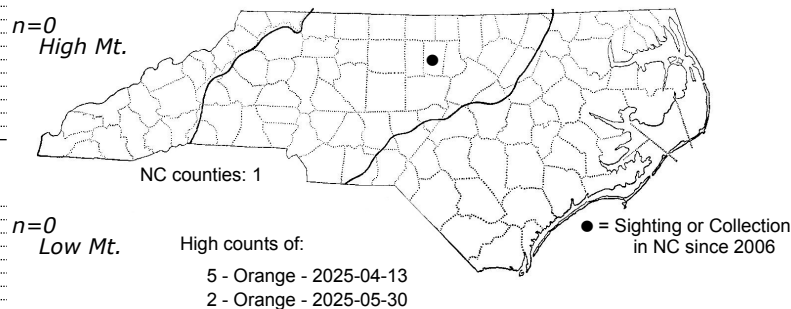
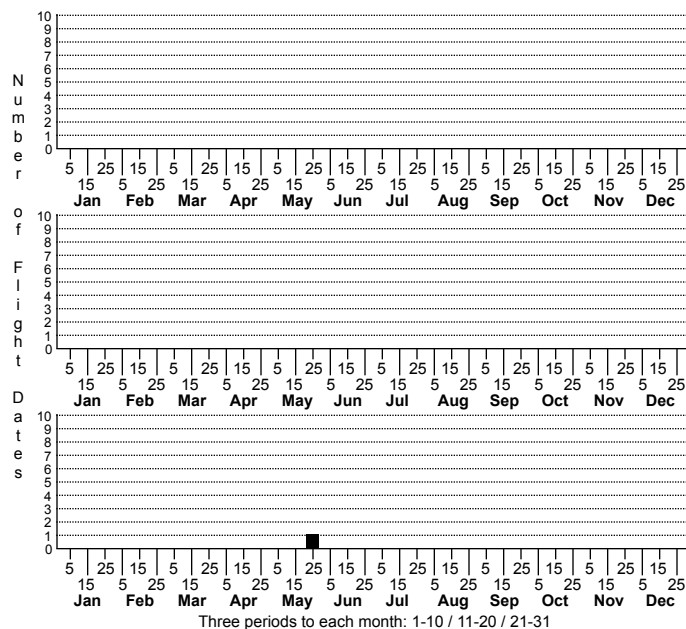
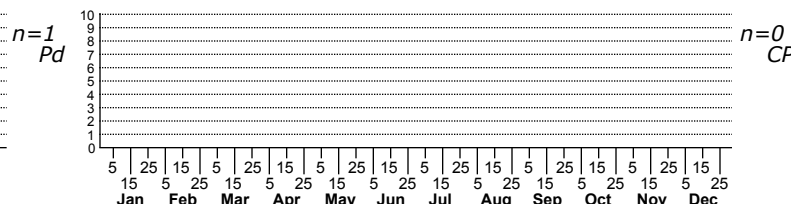

FOOD: A variety of hosts have been reported, including alder (*Alnus*), beech (*Fagus*), apple (*Malus*), poplar (*Populus*), cherry (*Prunus*), and willow (*Salix*) (Forbes, 1923; Bucheli et al., 2002; Falkovitsh, 2006). In North Carolina, Jeff Niznik reared a larva from Black Cherry (*Prunus serotina*).
