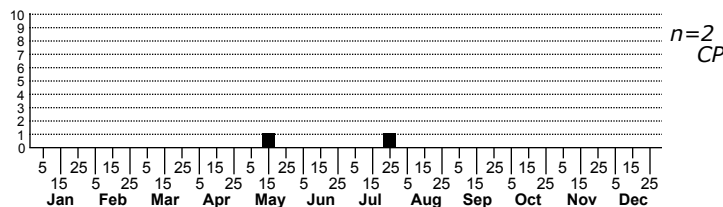
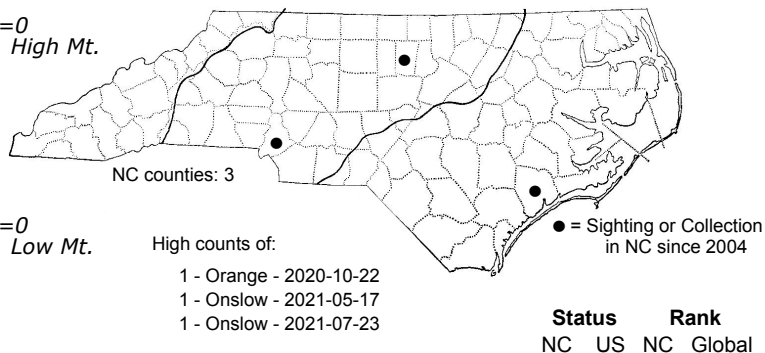
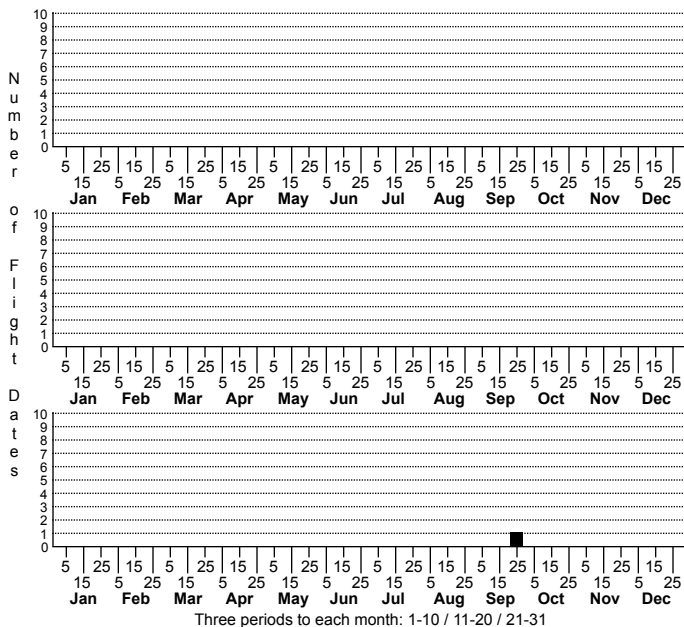

TAXONOMIC_COMMENTS: *Pyroderces* is a genus of small comet moths that are primarily found in tropical, subtropical and warm temperate parts of the world. They are well represented in Australia and the Old World tropics, and there are three species in North America. Hodges (1978) placed our three species in the genus *Pyroderces*, but Europeans usually place these in the genus *Anatrachyntis*.
