HABITAT:

FOOD: Larvae are leaf-rollers of several species of hardwood trees and shrubs, including birch ($\leq i$ >Betula</i>), ironwood ($\leq i$ >Ostrya</i>), chestnut ($\leq i$ >Castanea</i>), hazel ($\leq i$ >Corylus</i>), hickories ($\leq i$ >Carya</i>), and oaks ($\leq i$ >Quercus</i>) (Hodges, 1986). In North Carolina, we have reared a larva from a leaf-roll on hickory.
