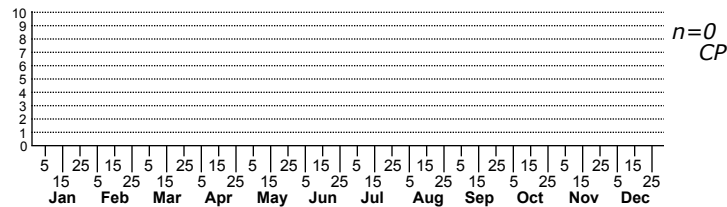
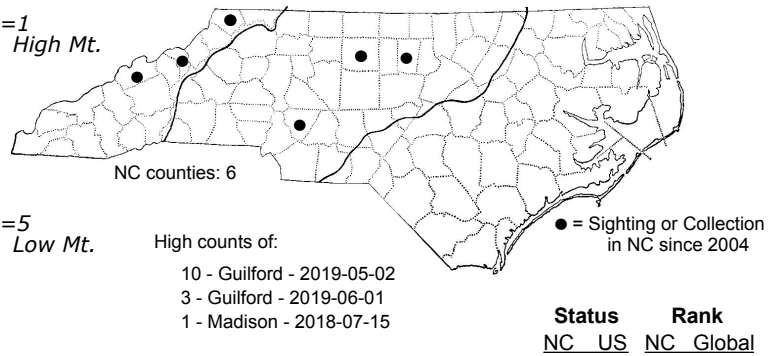
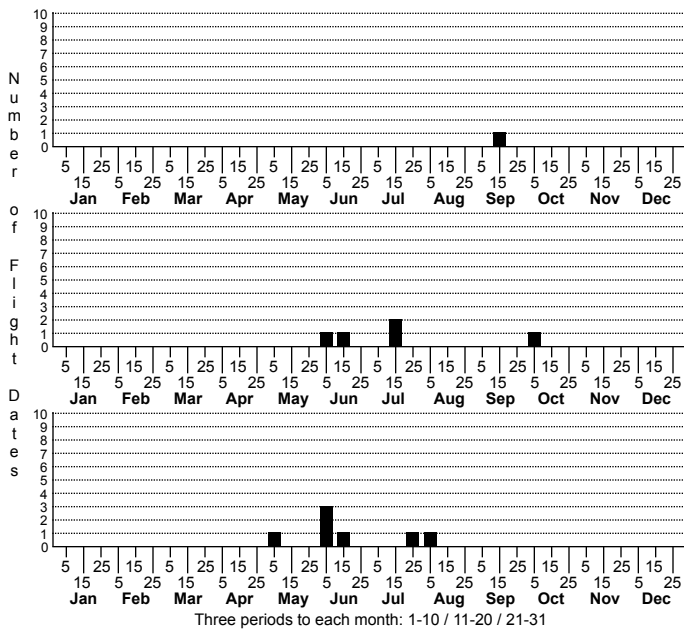

The basal black area extends to the costa but beyond the antemedian line there is often a broad triangular or rounded patch of white. The speculum is frequently pale and separated from the central pale patch by a black bar.
