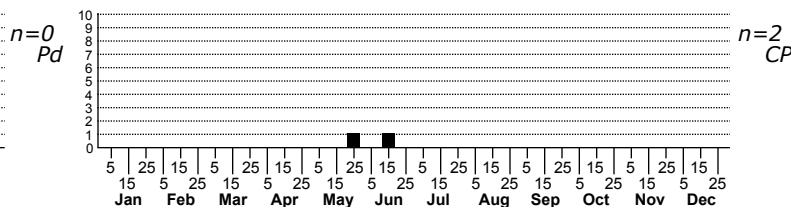
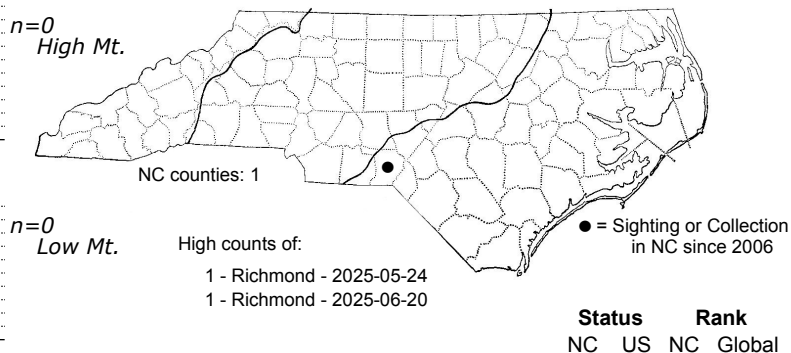
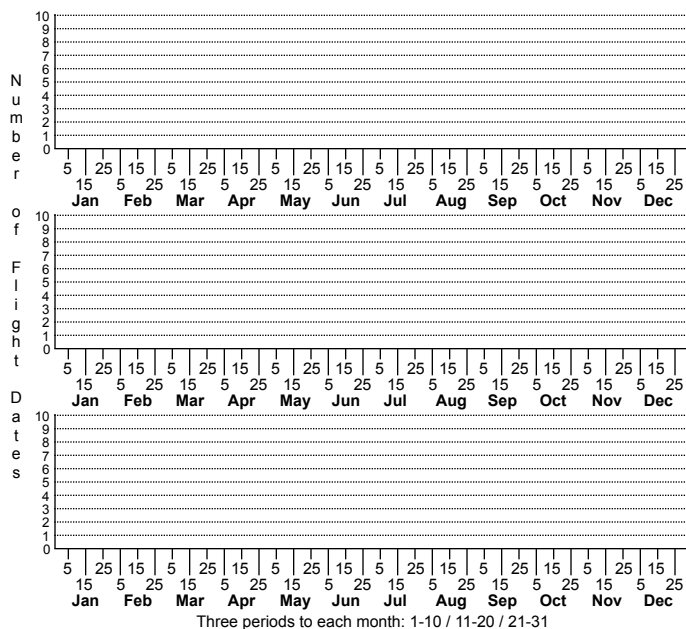

DISTRIBUTION: This species is primarily coastal, ranging from Massachusetts to New Jersey in the Northeast, but also occurs inland in Alabama and Arkansas (Powell and Brown, 2012).
