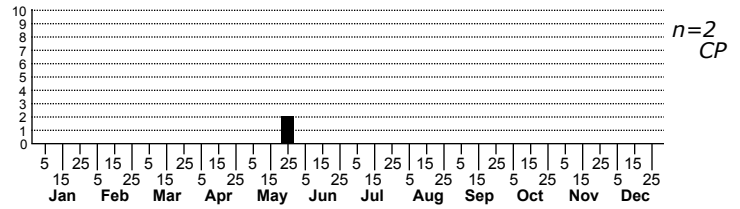
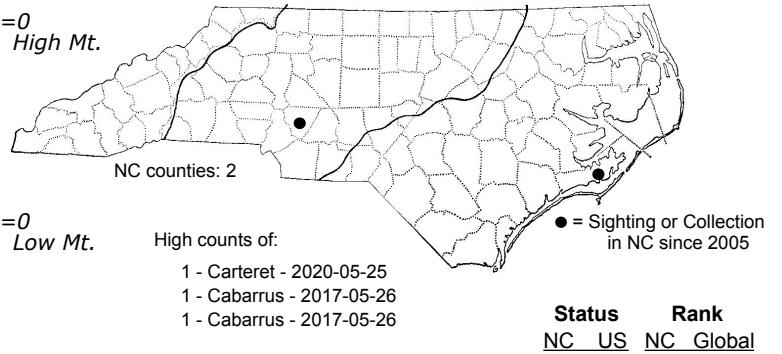
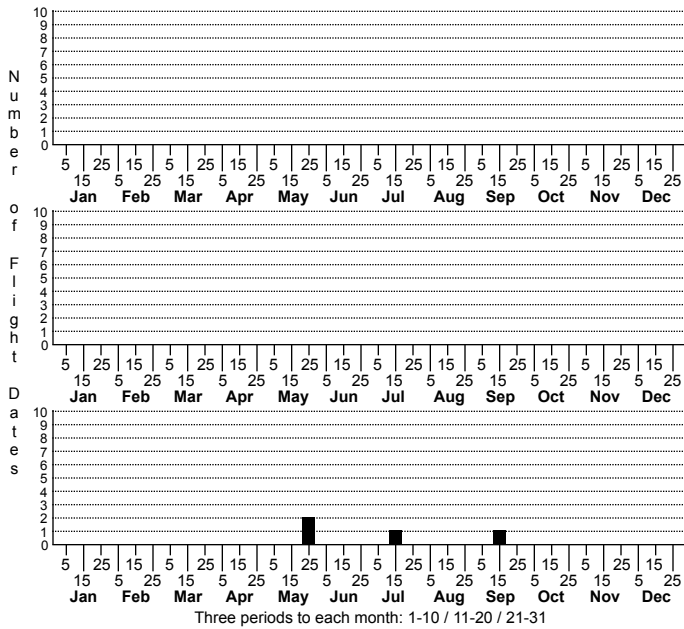

HABITAT:

FOOD: Larvae feed on stored plant material and can be a pest of tobacco and other crops. Robinson et al. (2010) report the following are used: Garden Onion (*Allium cepa*), caraway (*Carum*), *Citrus*, yam (*Dioscorea*), blanket-flower (*Gaillardia*), cotton (*Gossypium*), sunflower (*Helianthus*), Sweet Potato (*Ipomoea batatas*), Cultivated Tobacco (*Nicotiana tabacum*), Asian Rice (*Oryza sativa*), Potato (*Solanum tuberosum*), and Corn (*Zea mays*).
