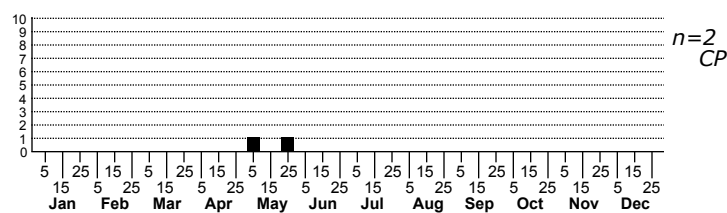
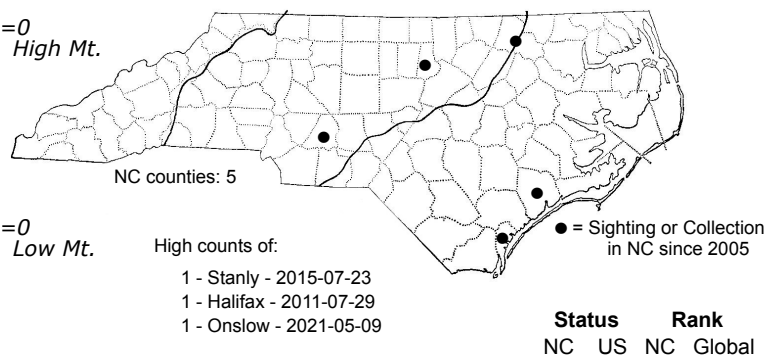
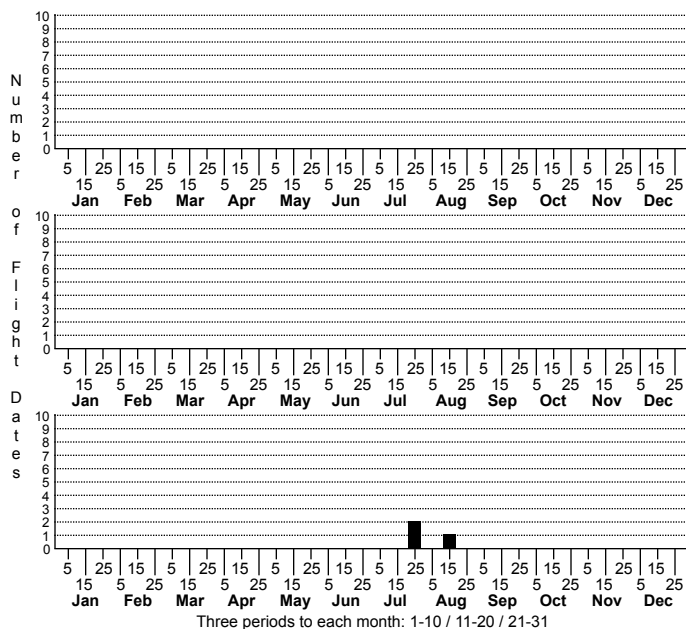


*Cryptothelea unidentified species* No common name



FAMILY: Psychidae SUBFAMILY: Psychinae TRIBE: [Psychini]

TAXONOMIC\_COMMENTS: *Cryptothelea gloverii* and *C. nigrita* are two closely related forms that can be separated by the antennal pectinations and associated sensory hairs. These require close examination, and it is difficult to identify specimens from photographs. *Cryptothelea nigrita* is a more southern form that has yet to be discovered in North Carolina, so the unidentified species shown here are most likely *C. gloverii*.
