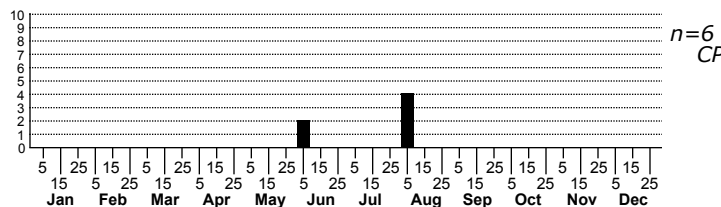
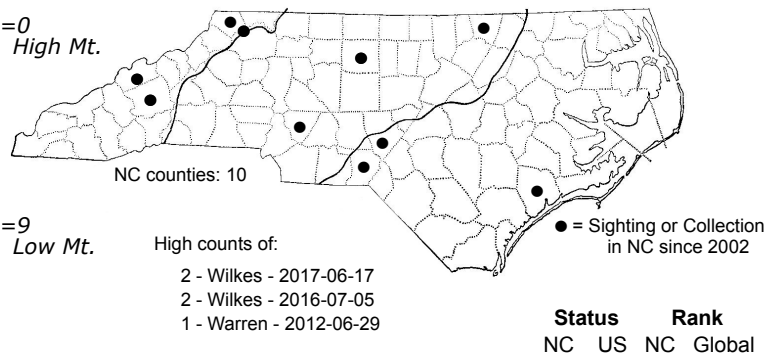
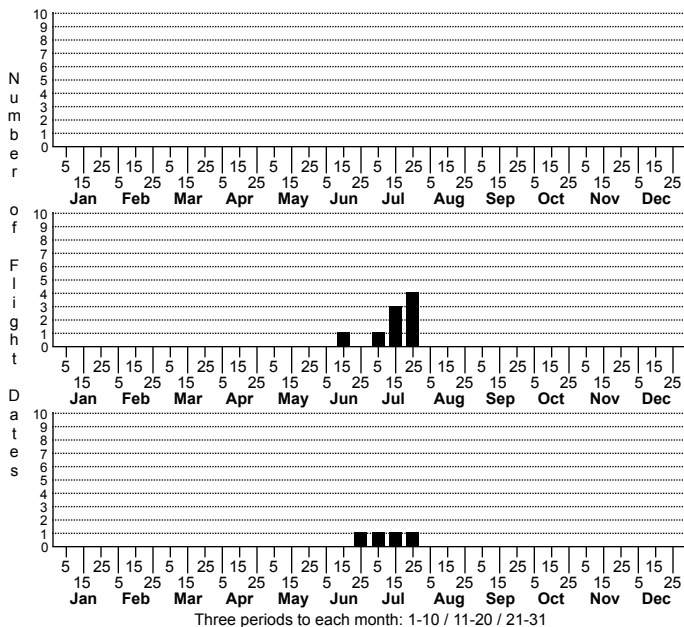

ID COMMENTS: The fringe on the forewing is two-toned, with the outer half pure white (Forbes, 1923; as *Glaphyria leniflualis*). In *Glaphyria sequestralis* the fringe is evenly ochre yellow and concolorous with the ground color. In *G. glaphyralis*, the fringe is evenly cream-white.
