



Marasmia trapezalis Trapeze Moth

DISTRIBUTION: This is a Neotropical species, found in both the Neotropics, Africa, India, Myanmar and the Galapagos (Landry, 2020). In North America, it occurs in Texas, Florida, and a few other sites in the Southeast.
