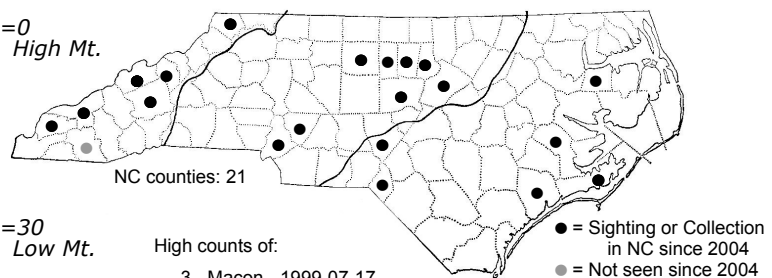
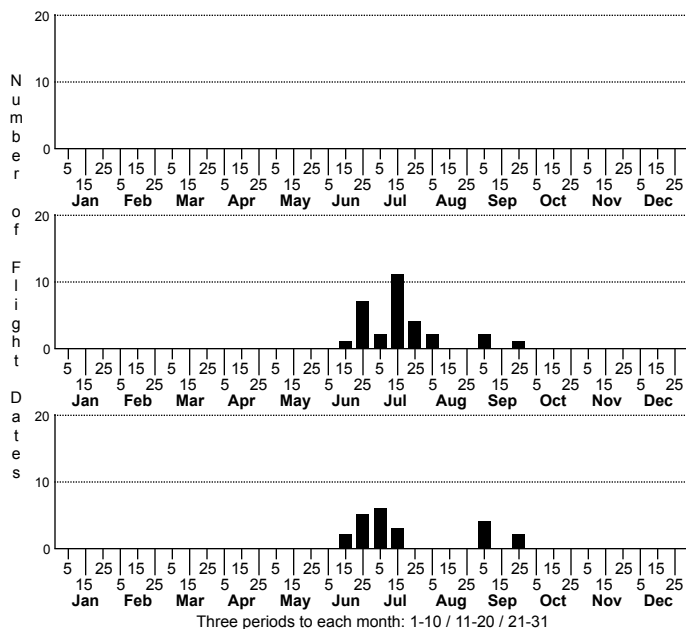


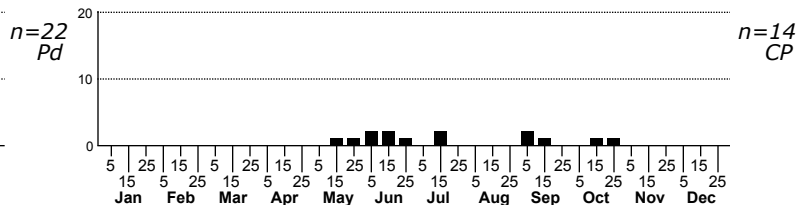
Galasa nigrinodis Boxwood Leaf-tier Moth
