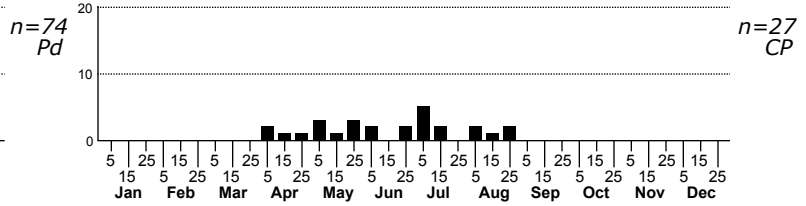
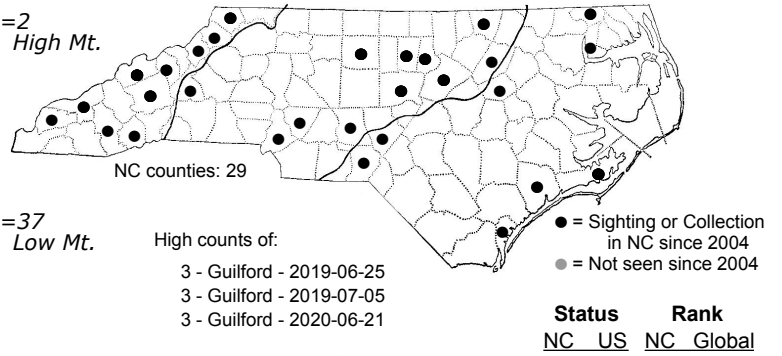
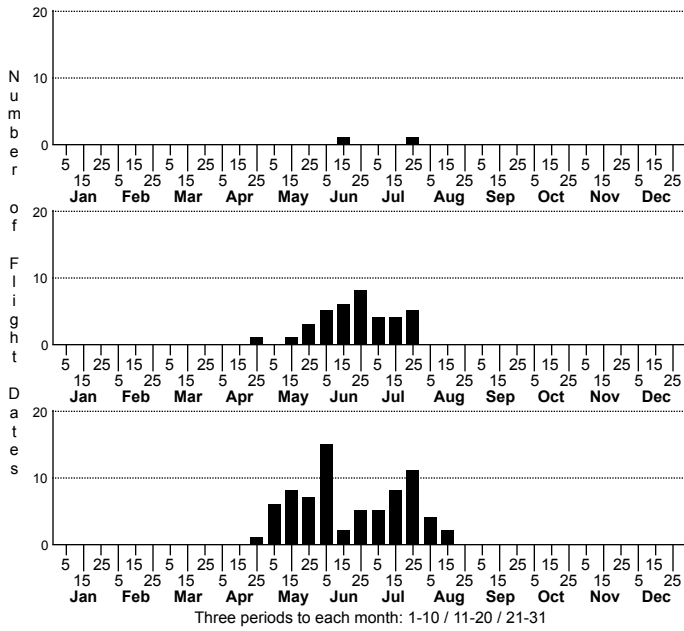


Epipaschia superatalis Dimorphic Macalla Moth
