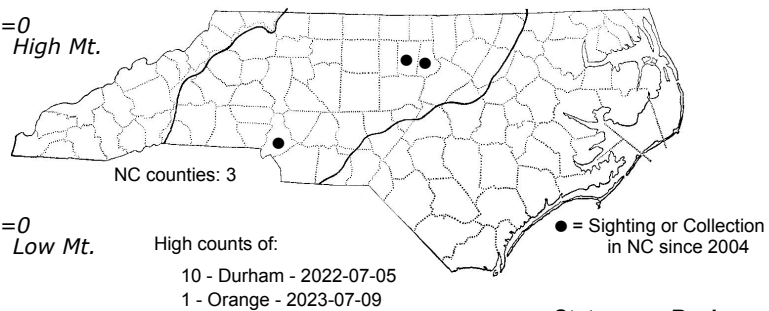
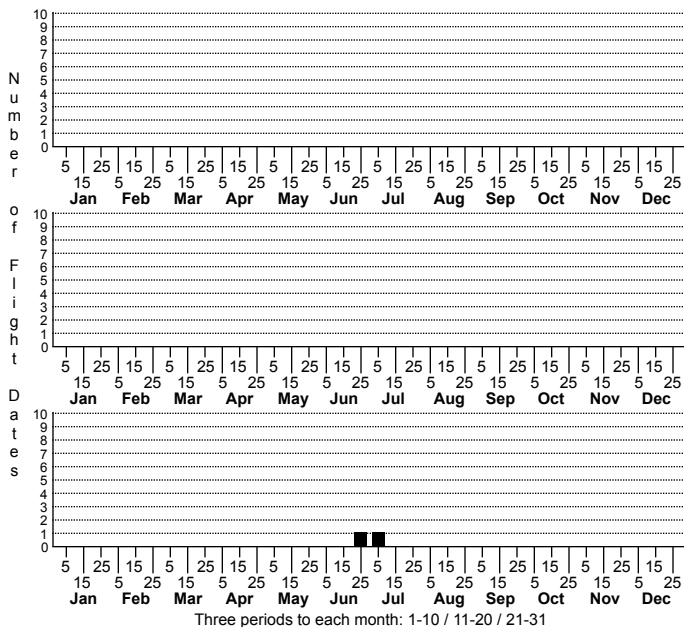
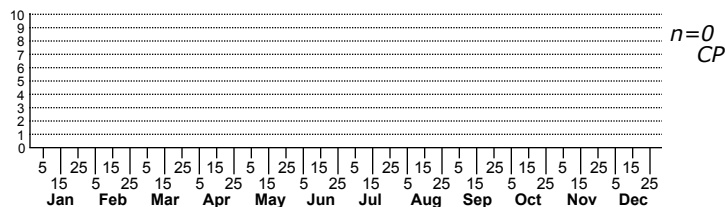

HABITAT: Our two records for this species come from stands of bottomland hardwoods

FOOD: Tracy Feldman found a colony of the larvae of this species feeding on Moonseed. Reports of this species on Asimina or Anonia may represent other species in this genus.

OBSERVATION\_METHODS: This species may come poorly to lights. Searching Moonseed populations for larvae may be the best way to document this species
