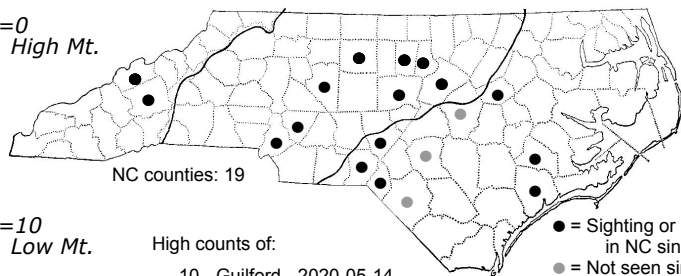
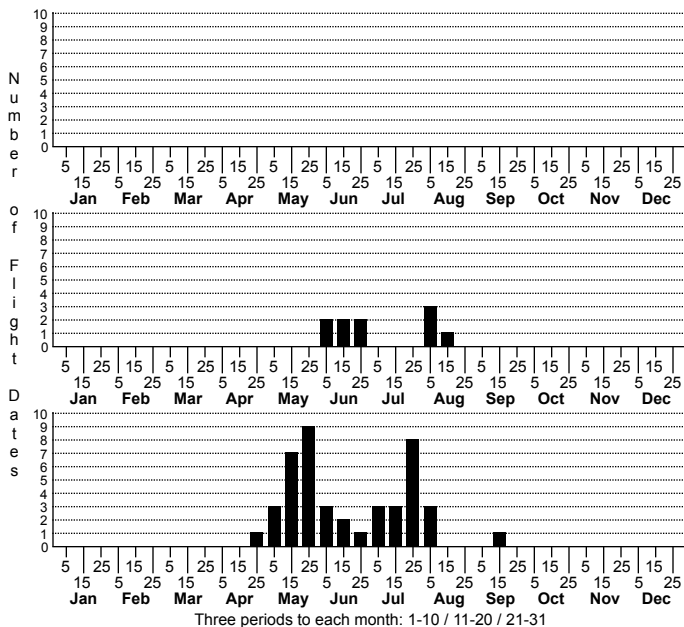


Acrobasis exsulella Cordovan Pyralid Moth

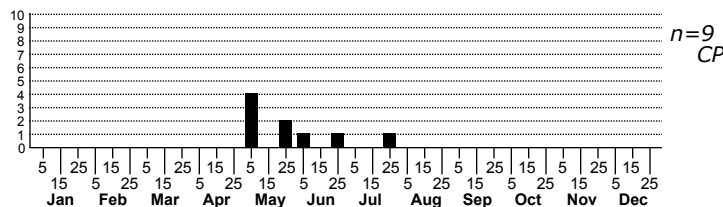

HABITAT: Most of our records come from sites where Mockernut Hickory occurs, including both mesic and dry stands of hardwoods.

FOOD: Larvae feed on Hickories, including *Carya tomentosa* and *C. illinoensis* (Neunzig, 1972).
