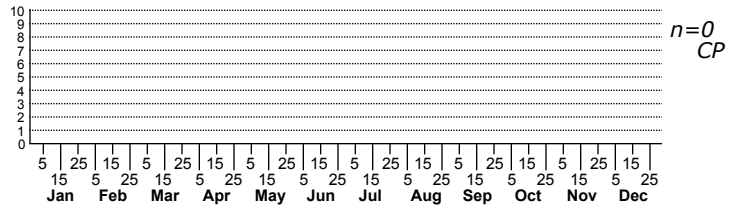
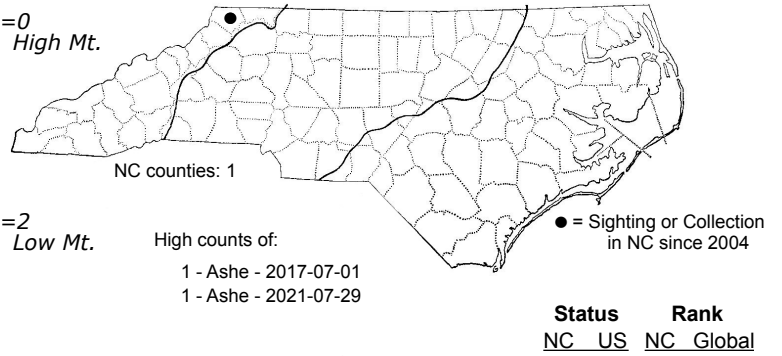
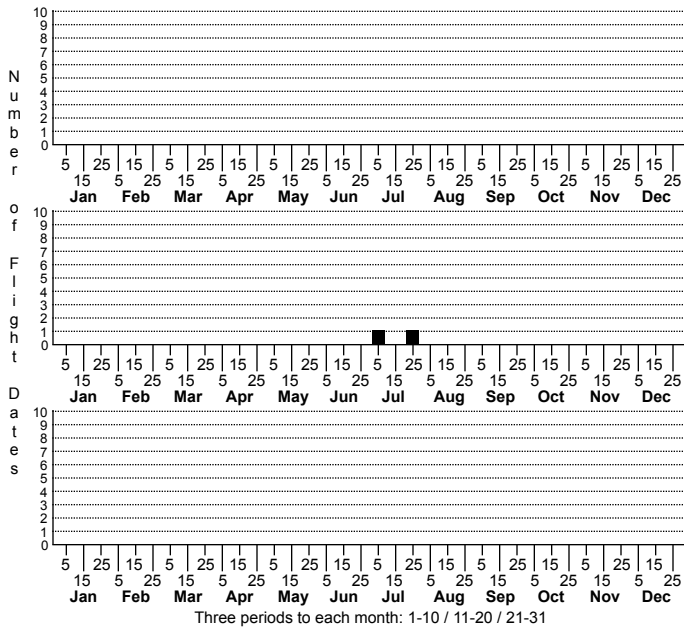

FOOD: Larvae are reported to feed on River Birch (Neunzig, 1975). River Birch has not been recorded in Ashe County where this species has been collected, so another species of birch (such as *Betula alleghaniensis* or *B. lenta*) could be serving as a host in North Carolina.
