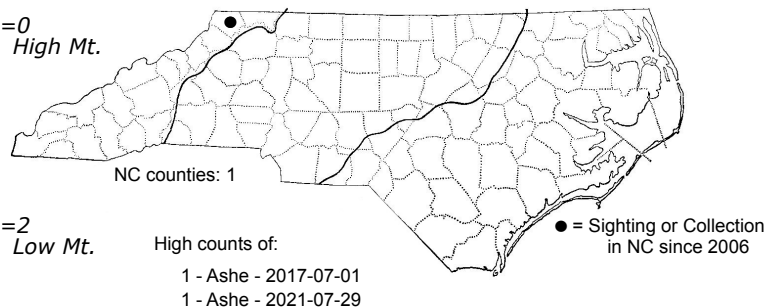
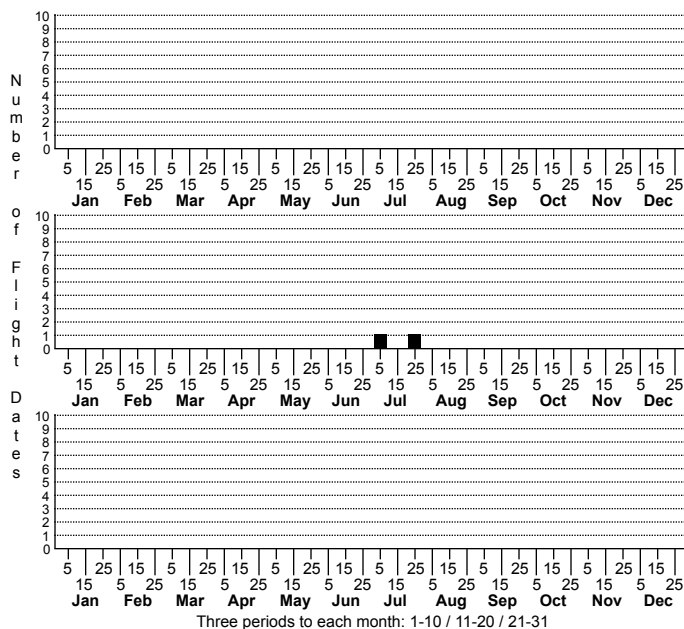
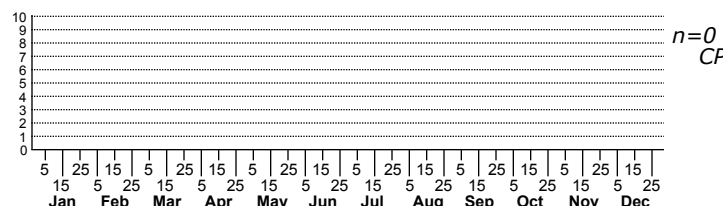

FOOD: Larvae are reported to feed on River Birch (*Betula nigra*) (Neunzig, 1975). River Birch is not typically found in Ashe County where this species has been collected, but a number had been planted near the collection site. It is also possible that another species of birch (such as *Betula alleghaniensis* or *B. lenta*) could be serving as a host in North Carolina.
