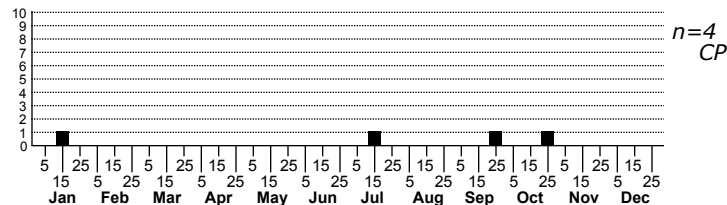
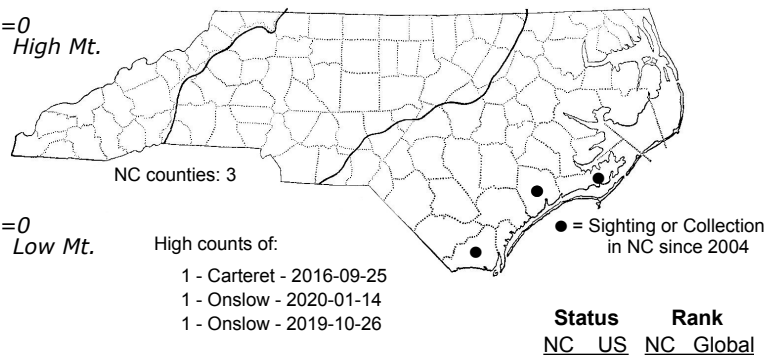


Atheloca subrufella Palm Bud Moth

FOOD: Larvae are reported to feed on Cabbage Palmetto (*Sabal palmetto*) (Heppner, 2007). In North Carolina, Cabbage Palmetto is probably only native to Bald Head Island in Brunswick County, though it has been planted in other coastal counties.
