




# *Bucculatrix new species 1* No common name

ID COMMENTS: This appears to be an undescribed species of *Bucculatrix*. As of 2025, it is currently only known from a few sites in the eastern Piedmont. Note the pure white scales that cover the head, thorax, and much of the basal two-thirds of the forewing, the two patches of dark-tipped scales on the apical half of the forewing, and the patch of dark, raised scales along the inner margin.
