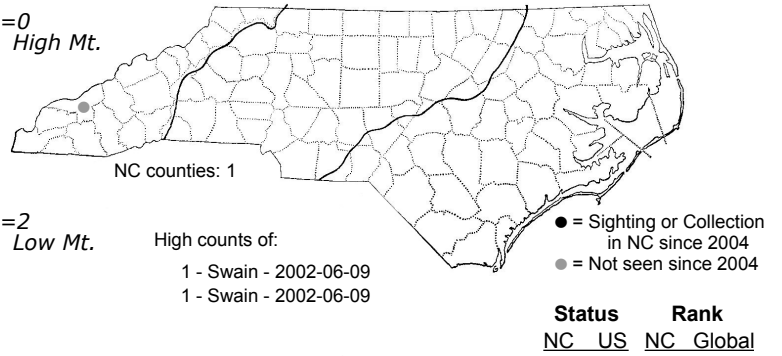
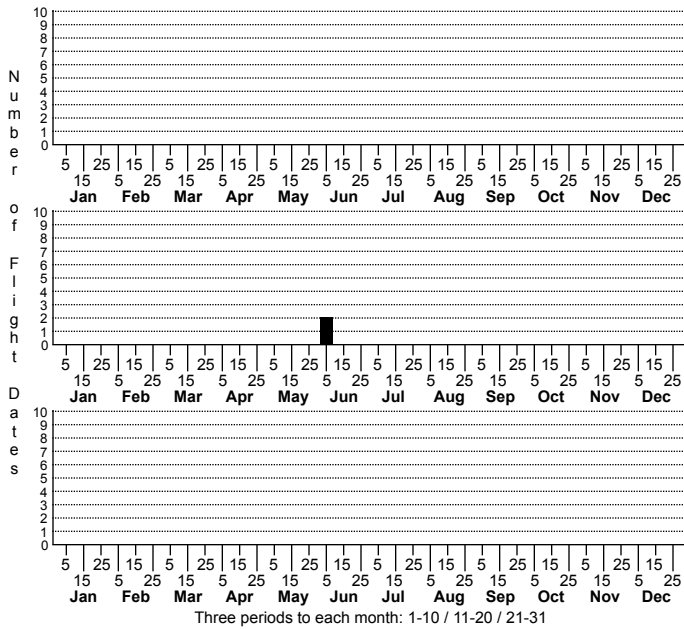

ID COMMENTS: The ground color of the forewings is mainly brown, with a dusting of white located along the anterior half (Neunzig, 2003). A patch of raised scales is located on the basal side along the antemedian line but both the antemedian and postmedian lines are weakly developed.
