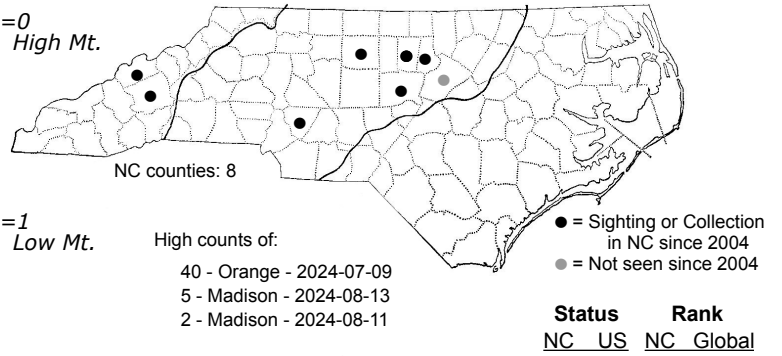
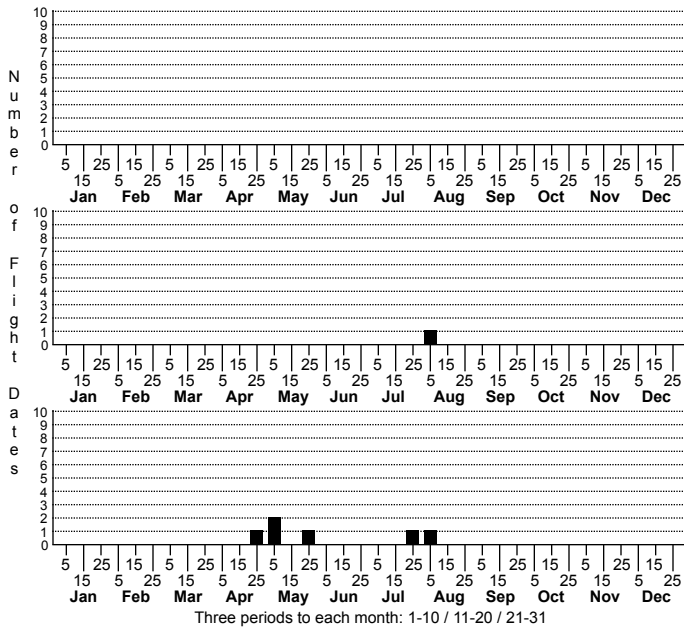

FOOD: The larvae appear to special on species of Gleditzia, including Water Locust (<i>Gleditsia aquatica</i>) in Florida and Honey Locust (<i>G. triacanthos</i>) elsewhere throughout the range (Forbes, 1923; Prentice, 1966; Neunzig (1979); Godfrey et al., 1987; Heppner, 2007; BugGuide).
