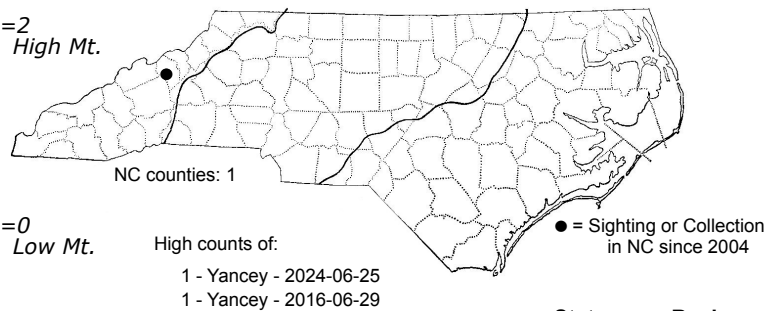
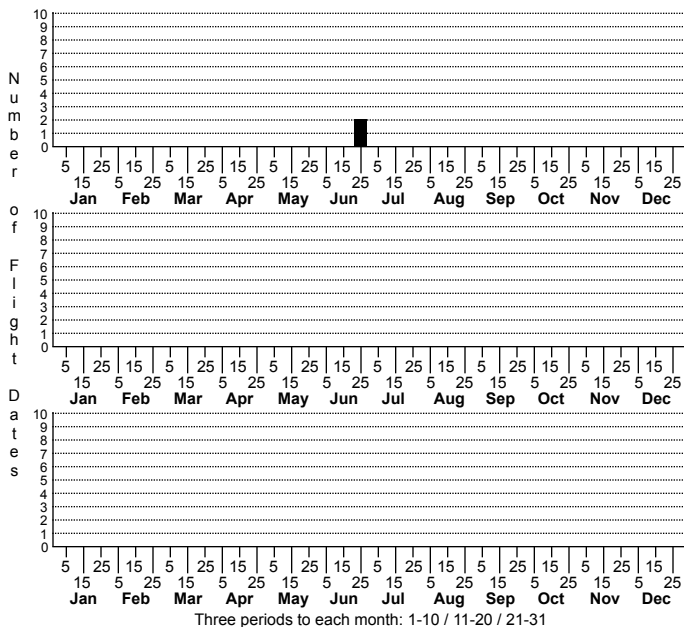
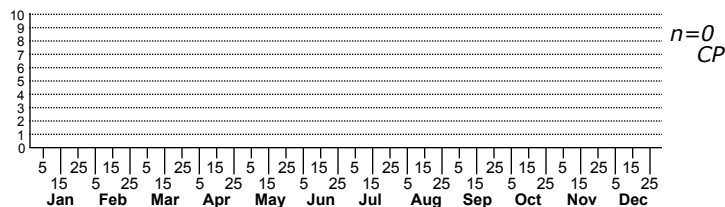

FOOD: Larvae reportedly feed on the Pinaceae - firs (<i>Abies</i> spp.), larches (<i>Larix</i> spp.), spruces (<i>Picea</i> spp.), and pines (<i>Pinus</i> spp.), including Eastern White Pine (<i>Pinus strobus</i>) (Robinson et al., 2024).
