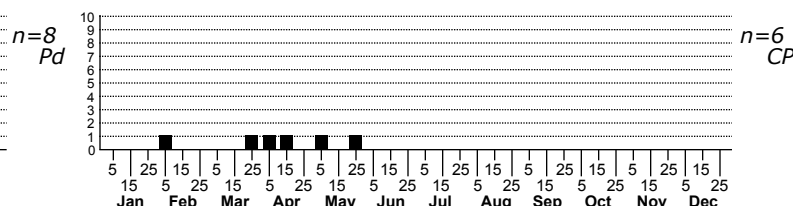
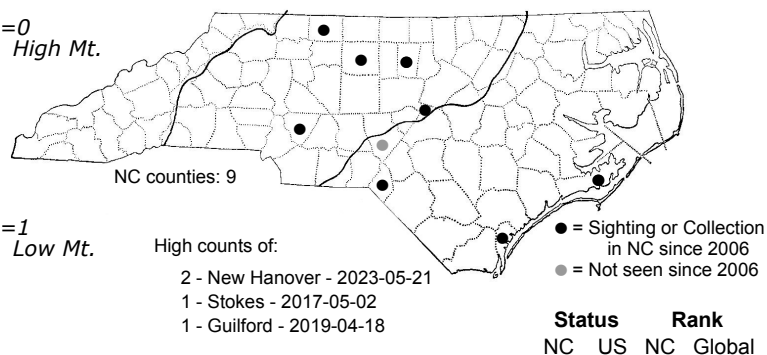
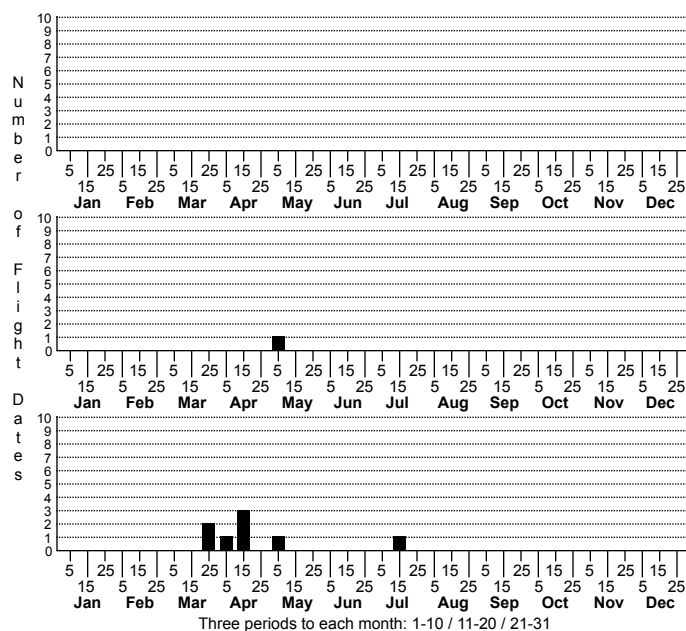

ID COMMENTS: "The forewing of myersella is mostly white with strongly contrasting dark-brown to black areas" (Neunzig, 1997). *L. fiskella* is similar "but the forewings are generally darker with the fuscous or black more widespread and not contrasting as much with the paler areas of the wing."
