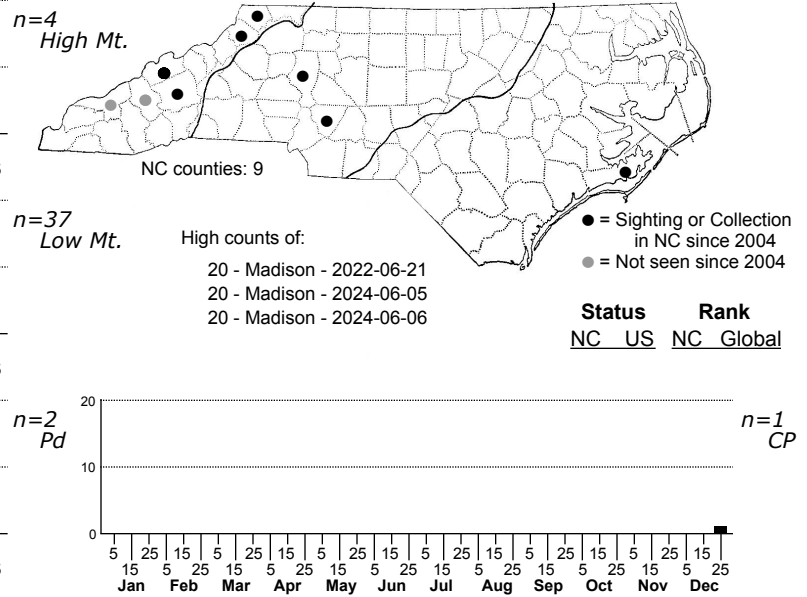
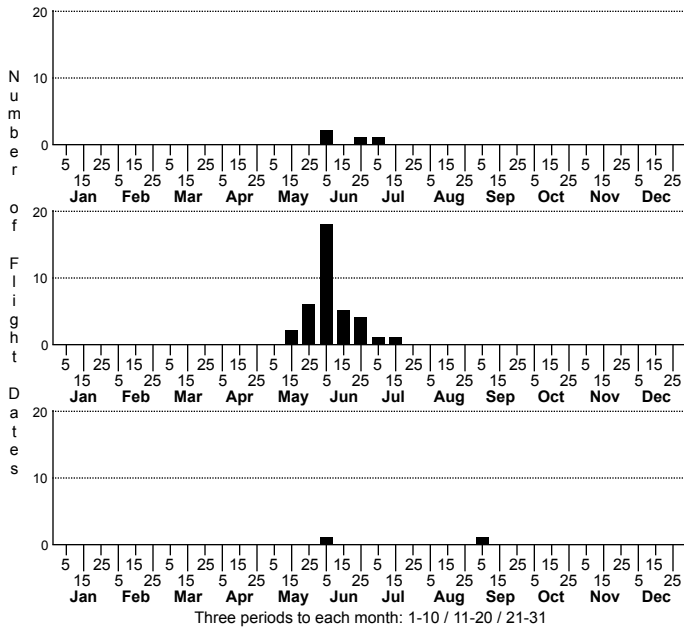


Vitula broweri Brower's Vitula Moth
