




Ephestia kuehniella Mediterranean Flour Moth

HABITAT:

FOOD: Larvae are apparently highly polyphagous, reported on a variety of crop plants including peanut, peppers, soybean, barley, rice, peas, rye, potato, wheat, and corn; but also on walnut, cherry, and oak (Robinson et al., 2010; Beadle & Leckie, 2018).
