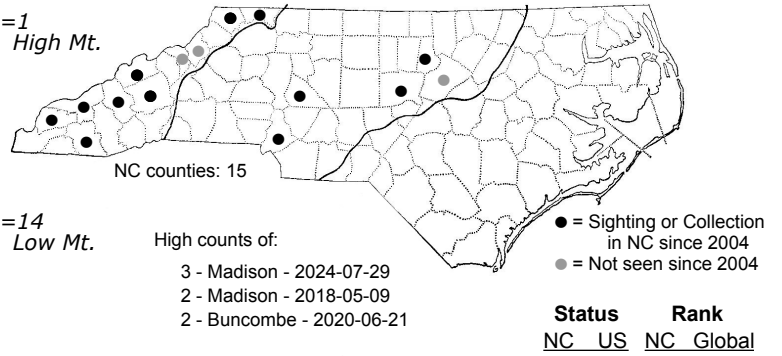
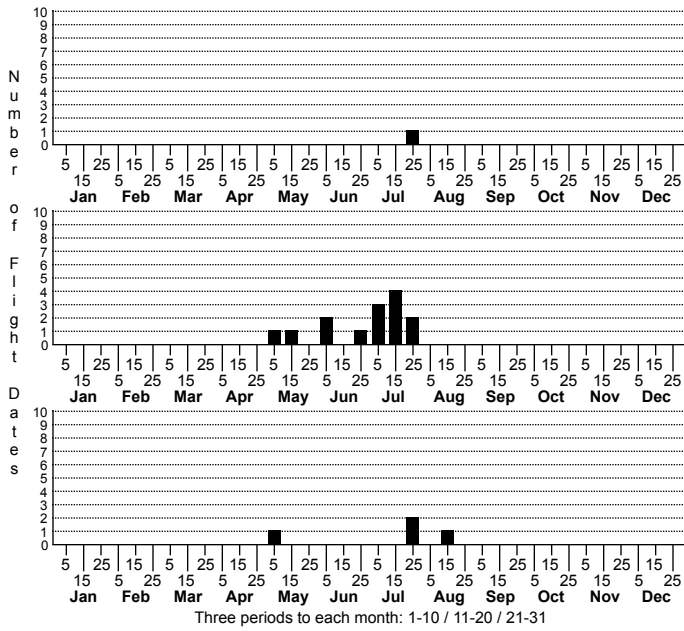

HABITAT:

FOOD: Larvae reportedly feed on *Clematis* and *Houstonia* (Forbes, 1923; Covell, 1984).

OBSERVATION_METHODS: The adults often nectar during the day on *Daucus*, *Asclepius*, *Erigeron* and other wildflowers.
