



FOOD: The HOSTS database reports a wide range of plants used outside the United States. Among the reported hosts relevant to North Carolina are Lanceleaf Frogfruit (<i>Phyla lanceolata</i>), Basil (<i>Ocimum basilicum</i>), and mullein (<i>Verbascum</i>) (Matthews et al., 1990; Robinson et al., 2010).
