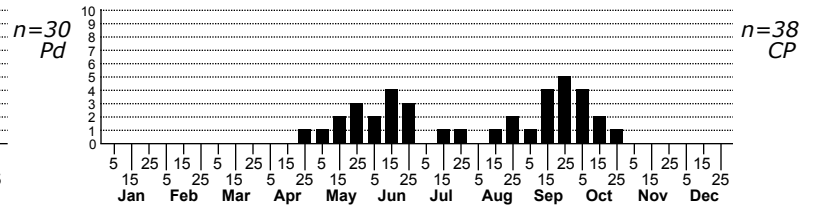
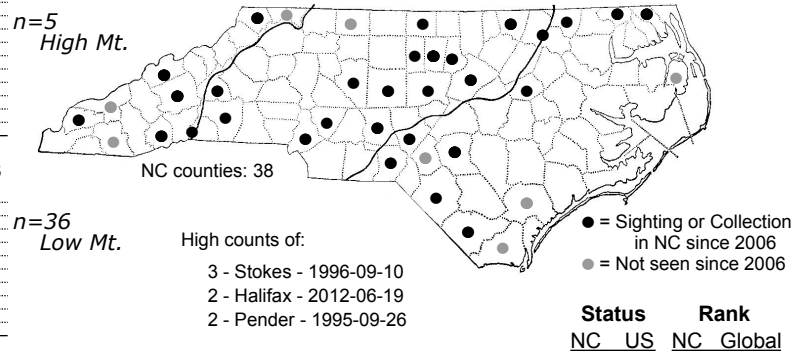
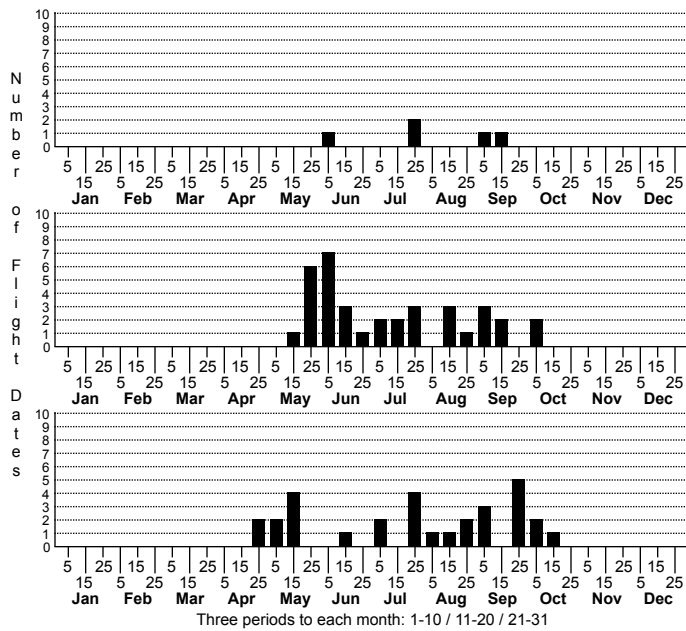


# *Oreta rosea* Rose Hooktip Moth

FOOD: Larvae feed on viburnums (Wagner, 2005). In North Carolina, larvae have been recorded feeding on Southern Arrowwood (*Viburnum dentatum*).
