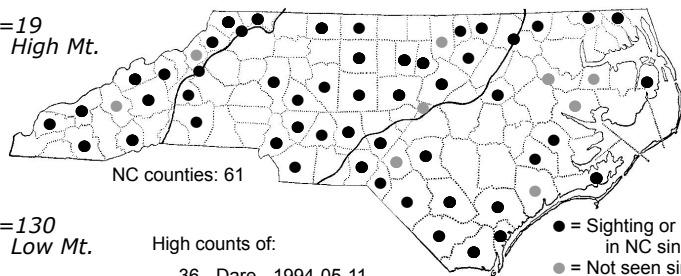
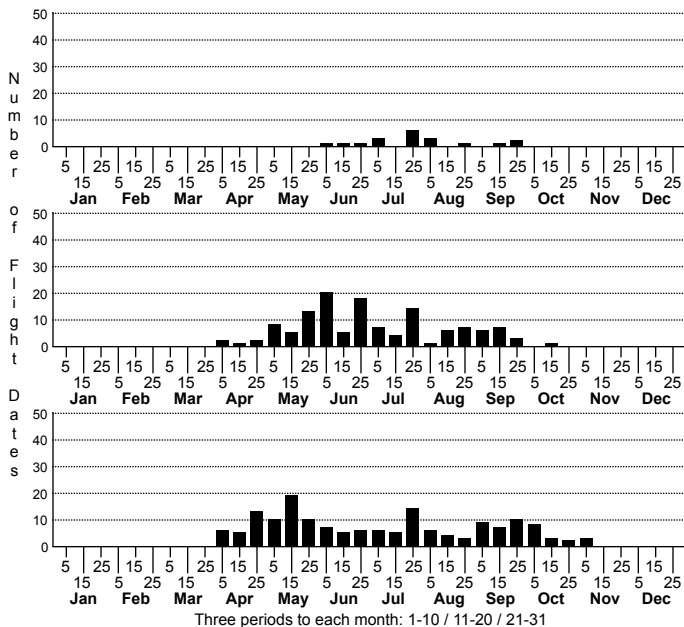

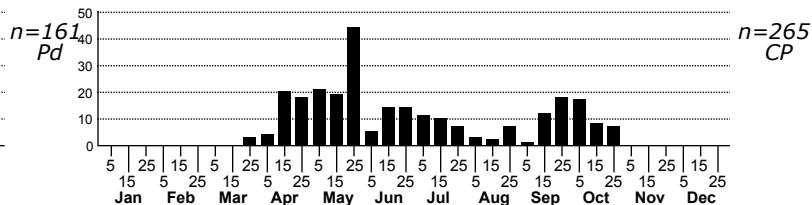

HABITAT: Our records come from a wide variety of forest, woodland, and shrubland habitats

FOOD: Larvae are broadly polyphagous on woody plants, including conifers as well as hardwoods (Wagner, 2005). In North Carolina, it has been observed feeding on Yaupon Holly and Boxelder.
