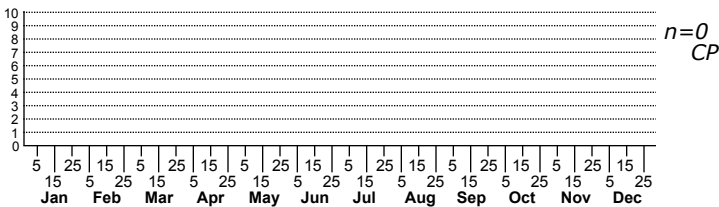
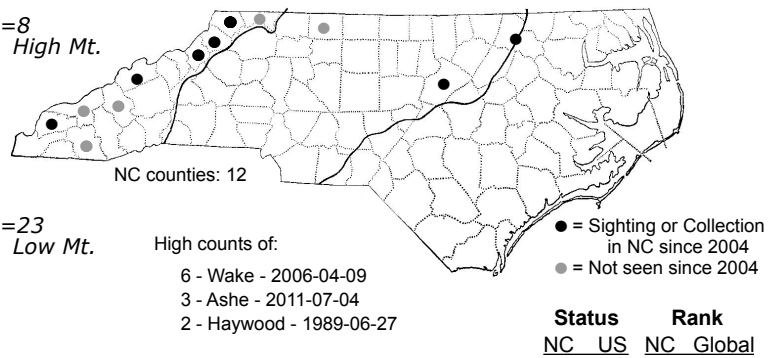
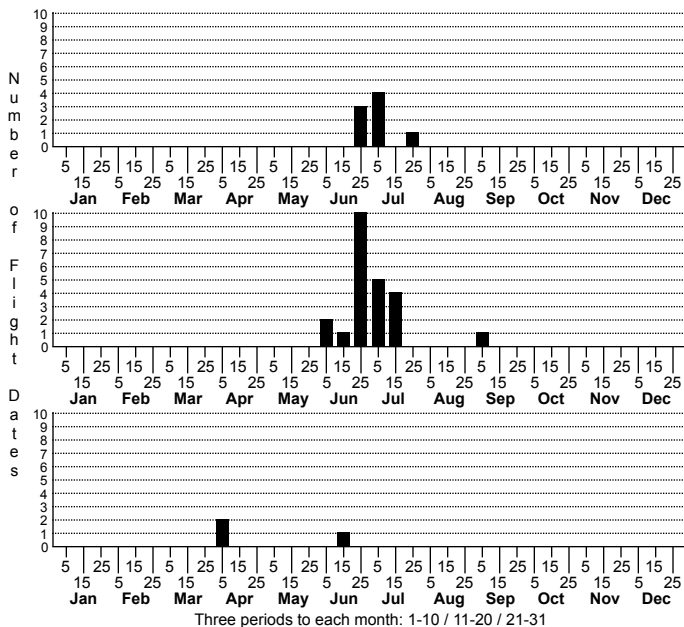


*Euchlaena serrata* Saw-wing Moth
