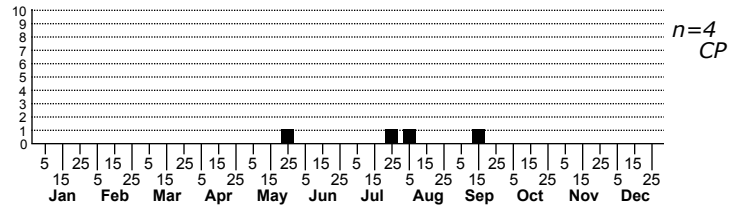
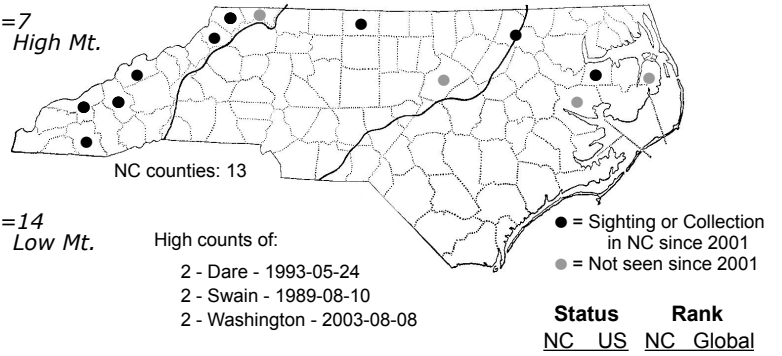
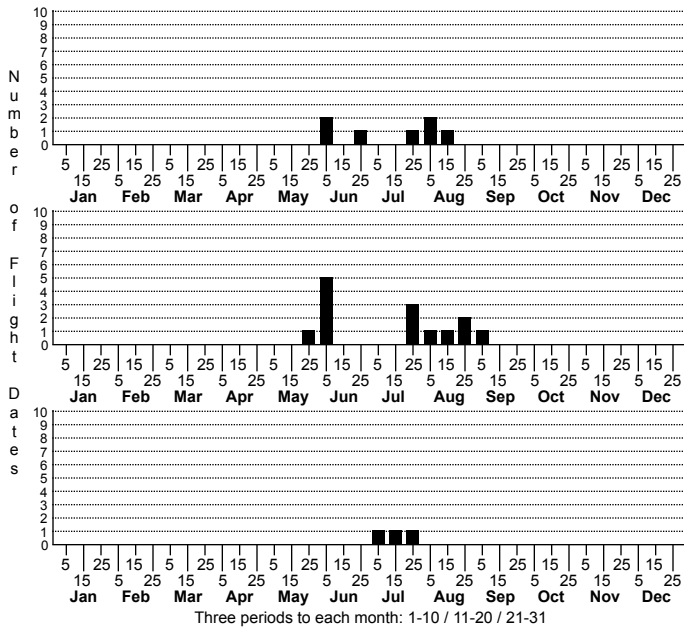


Xanthotype urticaria False Crocus Geometer Moth

HABITAT: North Carolina records come mainly from the Mountains where it has been found in high elevation hardwood forests, meadows, and bogs. In the Piedmont and Coastal Plain, it has been recorded primarily from riparian, lake, and pond shoreline habitats.

FOOD: Polyphagous, feeding on a wide range of woody and herbaceous plants but apparently not on conifers (Wagner et al., 2001)
