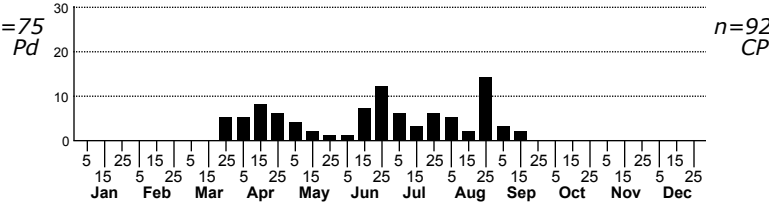
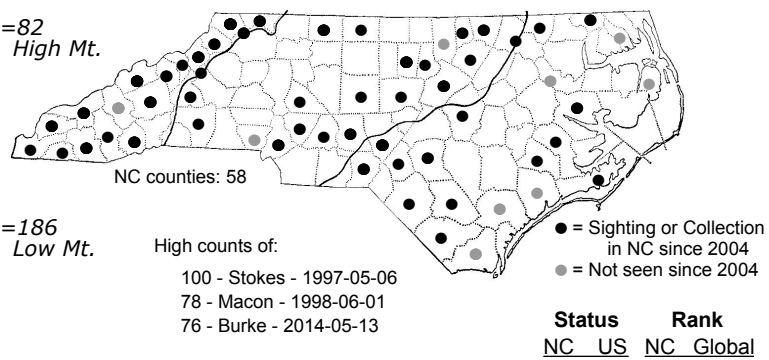
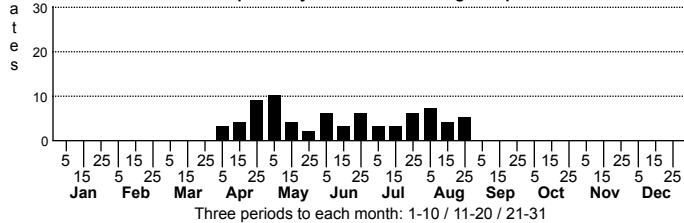
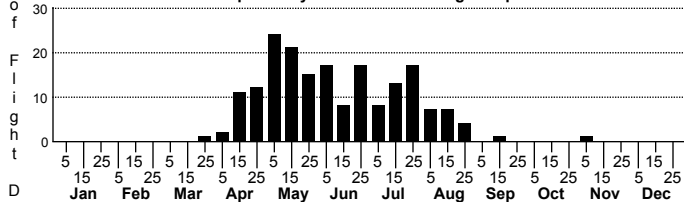
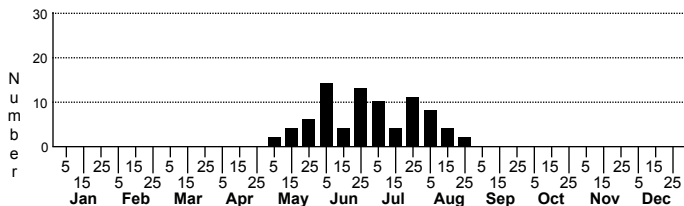


Probole amicaria Friendly Probole Moth

FOOD: Polyphagous, with larvae feeding on a wide range of hardwood trees and shrubs; also reported on Spruce (Wagner et al., 2001)
