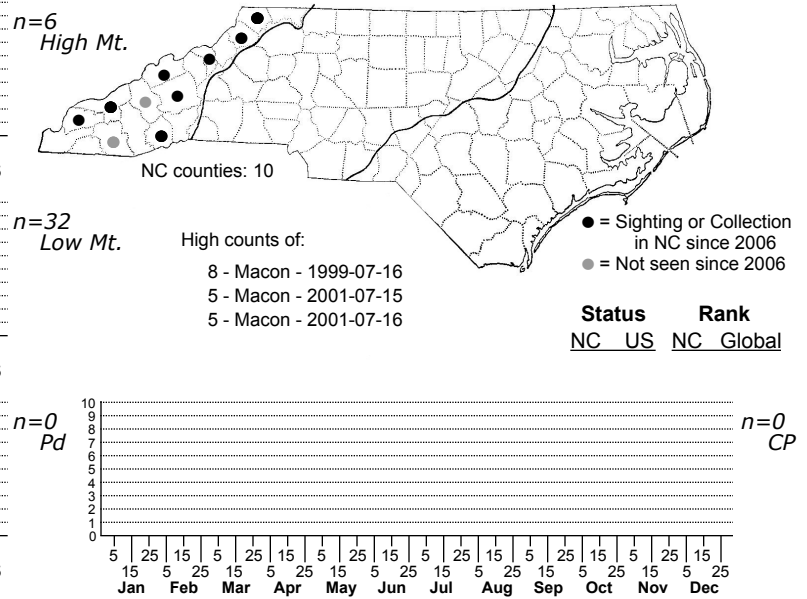
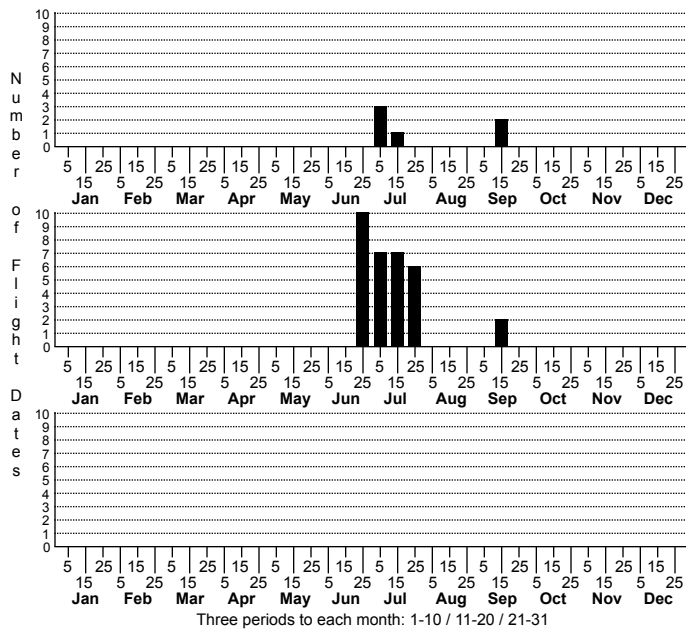


Eugonobapta nivosaria Snowy Geometer

HABITAT: Forests and woodlands (Wagner et al., 2001). Our records come from cove forests, high elevation forests, bogs, and montane riparian habitats.

FOOD: Larvae are broadly polyphagous, feeding on many hardwood trees and shrubs, including cherry (*Prunus*) and dogwood (*Cornus*), as well as forbs such as blue cohosh (*Caulophyllum*), meadow-rue (*Thalictrum*), and sweet-cicely (*Osmorhiza*) (Wagner et al., 2001). We do not have any feeding records in North Carolina.
