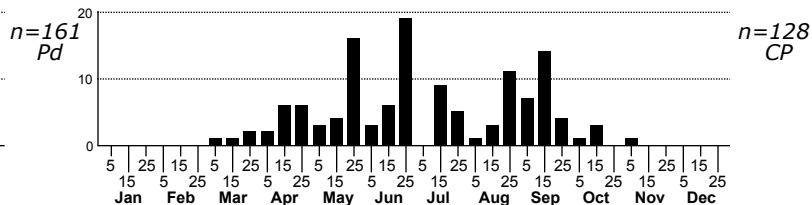
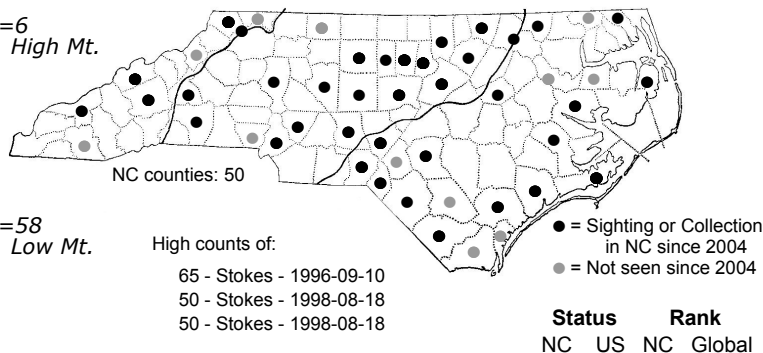
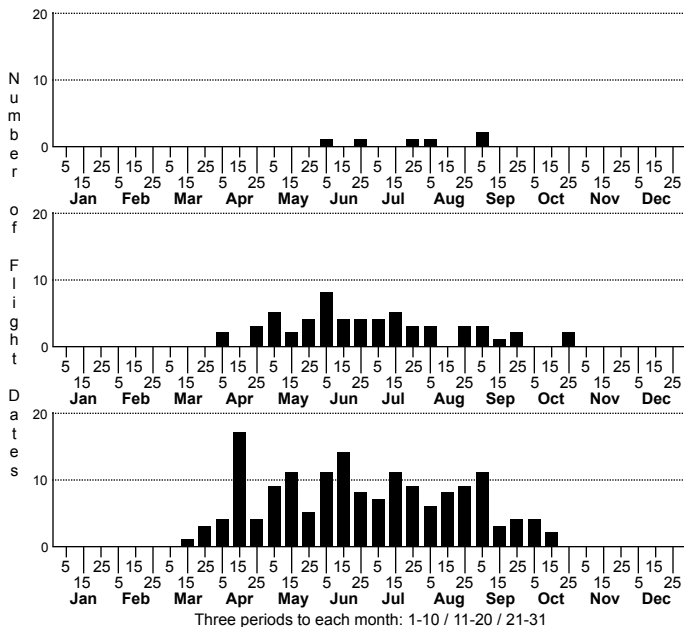


# *Cyclophora packardi* Packard's Wave Moth
