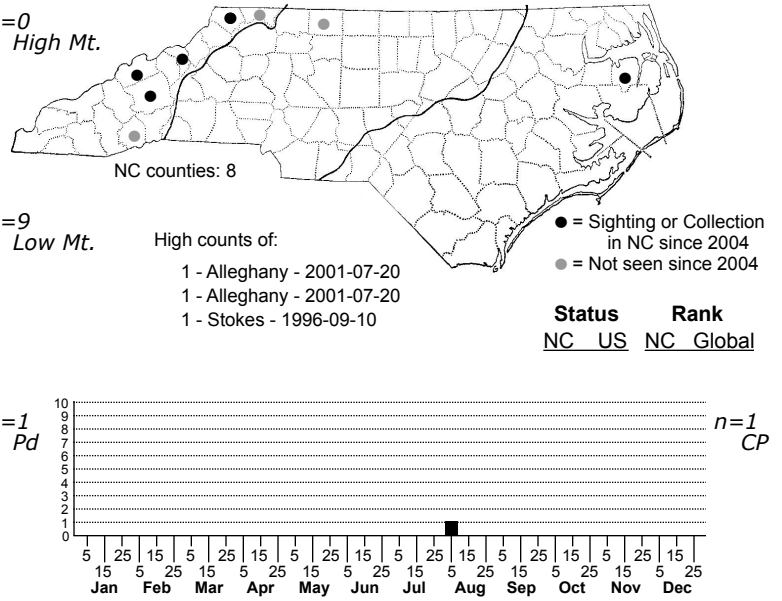
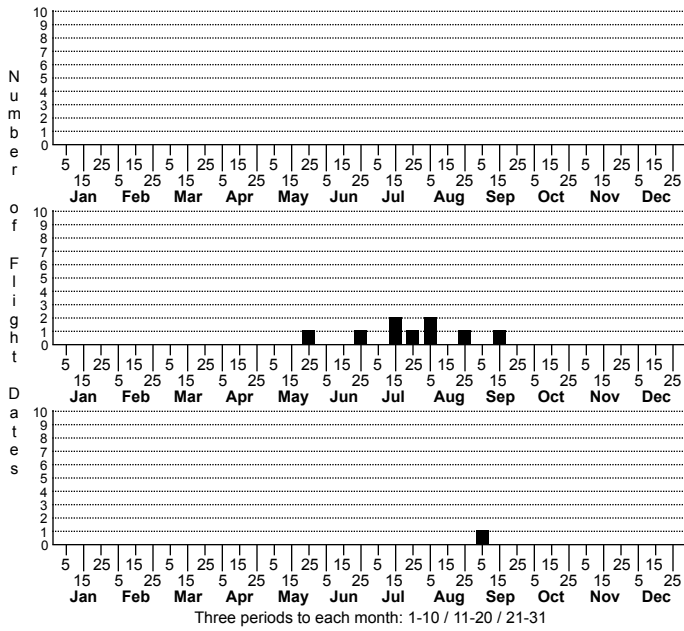


Timandra amaturaria Cross-lined Wave Moth
